

SHRINERS TO BRING CALIFORNIA ORANGES

Vanguard of Los Angeles Nobles Reaches City.

TRAINS READY TO START

Southern Nobility Busy Arranging for Great Hegira to Portland; Seattle to Entertain.

All the nobility of Southern California Shrinedom is busily arranging for the great hegrira to the convention city of the country, and they are bringing hundreds, maybe thousands, of boxes of oranges with them for free distribution. This is the latest word from the sunny south, which reached the Shrine headquarters yesterday.

The famous California band, patrol and chanters of the Los Angeles temple will be here in full force and already some of the advance guard has arrived in the city, several Los Angeles nobles showing their faces yesterday at headquarters. They report that hundreds are coming on two special trains.

Visitors Ready to Depart. Potentate Louis N. Cole of Al Malakah temple is in charge of all arrangements and, according to reports, everything is in readiness to the ring of the bell on the engines of both trains. The Los Angeles boys will be quartered at the Elmal Frith club, and with hundreds of boxes of oranges to distribute, doubtless the hall will be a popular rendezvous.

Portland Shriners who were in attendance at the Indianapolis convention last year will remember the feature demonstration by California Land of Sunshine patrol, which distributed hundreds of boxes of oranges from big motor trucks piloted through the streets by the fezzed visitors. And Portland and her visitors, north, east, south and west, are, according to reports promised a similar, though better, treat.

Among those from Los Angeles who will receive a great welcome in Portland this month are Noble Leo V. Younsworth, who, at Indianapolis, was elected imperial outer guard of North America, and at the meeting here will go one step farther up the ladder of succession.

Los Angeles Special June 21. The Los Angeles double-header special train will leave the southern city June 19 and will arrive here on June 21. Their plans call for an immediate exit from the convention city as soon as the imperial sessions are over, that they may arrive home in time to start the long series of post-convention entertainments to be given there for eastern visitors who plan to return east via the southern route.

It is estimated that the total strength of the Los Angeles delegation here will be about 400. In order to be able to properly entertain the thousands of Shriners who will visit Los Angeles on their return trip and also on their way here, members of Al Malakah temple have organized an automobile club and permanent entertainment committee, which will be called the Al Malakah Caravan club.

Seattle to Entertain Delegates. News which has reached the Shrine headquarters indicates that Los Angeles will have nothing on Seattle for entertainment of eastern visitors, and not only is the northern metropolis to be a riot of color, but they will have listed close to 2000 autos by which the visitors will be conveyed over the King county highways and byways. Tacoma is doing likewise.

Manager McGettigan of the Orpheum yesterday announced that he had ordered cots to be placed in the theater to care for his actors and actresses during Shrine week. They say it will be a real theater party that week at the Orpheum, but the party will be behind the scenes. Mr. McGettigan says there are hundreds of Shriners already in the city from out-of-town points, according to inquiries he has had as to whether or not the Orpheum will have a show Shrine week. He said Joe Howard would be the headliner for the week.

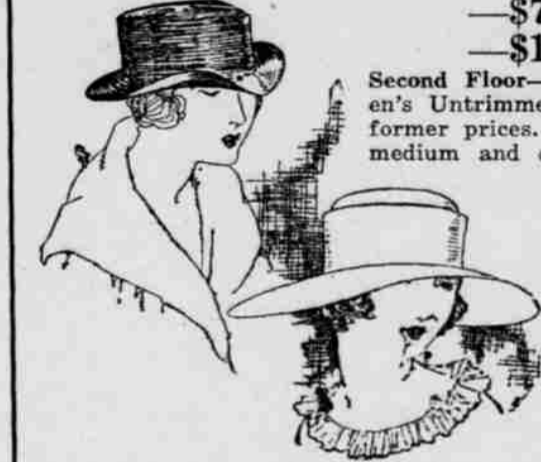
