

PORTLANDER CHOSEN TO HEAD BANKERS

N. U. Carpenter New President of State Body.

EUGENE SESSIONS ENDED

Non-Partisan League Condemned in Resolutions Adopted During Closing Work.

EUGENE, Or., June 16.—(Special.)—N. U. Carpenter of the Hartman & Thompson bank of Portland was today elected president of the Oregon Bankers' association for the coming year. William G. Tait of the First National bank of Medford was the choice for vice-president; J. L. Hartman of Hartman & Thompson, Portland, is secretary, and Floyd Rice of the First National bank of Pendleton is treasurer.

Among the resolutions adopted by the convention at the closing session this forenoon was one completely disapproving of the Non-partisan league and its operations and that the association conduct a campaign to oppose the activities of the league's organization who are said to be already working in Oregon and who are expected to increase their numbers in the near future. Other resolutions adopted follow:

That the work of the American institute of banking, its officers and members receive the full approval of the association.

Interest Rate Opposed.
That American institutions and citizens receive the full approval of the association and that it endorse Americanism, its laws and ideals and that an effort be made to further Americanism.

That the association denounces the proposed 5 per cent interest amendment and that it co-operate and expose the amendment.

That the public school system be favored and a just compensation be paid those employed in this service.

That the work of the agricultural committee of the association is approved and endorsed by the association and efforts be made to increase further the dairy and livestock and allied interests in the state.

Sensible Likely Choice.
That as Oregon now ranks second in the sale of war saving certificates, the hearty co-operation of the association is urged and every effort be made to place Oregon first on the list.

That the president of the association appoint a resolutions committee of five at least 30 days before each annual session, as the present system does not allow sufficient time for the framing of proper resolutions.

That the citizens of Eugene be thanked for the entertainment given the bankers while in convention.

The 1921 convention probably will be held at Seaside.

L. L. Paget of that city extended an invitation to meet there and the invitation, received with cheers, was referred to the executive committee.

The afternoon was given over to sightseeing and other amusements, some of the bankers and their wives accepting the hospitality of the Country club on the golf links while others went on automobile excursions.

PUBLIC SAFETY INVOLVED

FIRM SEEKING PERMIT FOR GASOLINE TANKS.

City Council Concludes to Defer Decision Until Return of Mayor Baker.

Repatriate came into play yesterday morning when the city council heard the petition of the Northwest Bridge & Iron company for permission to install three gasoline storage tanks with a capacity of 3000 gallons. Commissioner C. A. Bigelow, presiding in the absence of Mayor Baker, opposed the application of W. H. Cutlers, manager of the concern, who was present to address the council, while Commissioner John M. Mann believed the petition should be granted because Portland would benefit thereby.

"This is clearly a question of public safety," declared Commissioner Bigelow, "and you ought to realize that, although yours is a large concern, you have no authority to come to us and ask us to do something which is illegal."

Mr. Cutlers pointed out that unless his company received permission to install the tanks, it would be forced to suspend present and possibly future operation, thus denying employment to about 4000 men.

"What does your payroll amount to?" asked Commissioner Mann.

"Oh, about \$5,000,000 every year," replied Mr. Cutlers.

"Well, in that case I think we might be able to help you," was Mr. Mann's assertion. However, Commissioner Bigelow intervened.

"This matter will be laid on the table until the recovery of Mayor Baker," he said. "You must remember, Mr. Mann, that this question must be decided upon the basis of public safety and not politics."

HIGH CANADIAN ELK PORTLAND VISITOR

Joseph F. Morris Guest of Local Lodgement.

SOCIAL ALLIANCE SOUGHT

Affiliation With Dominion Order to Be Requested at National Convention in Chicago.

Social alliance between the Elk lodges of Canada and those of the United States may be brought about at the forthcoming national convention of the order in the United States in Chicago on July 3, according to plans now being formulated by the Portland chapter and by the Canadian organization under the leadership of Joseph F. Morris, grand and exalted ruler of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks in Canada.

Mr. Morris, who is a real estate and financial agent of Vancouver, B. C., arrived in Portland yesterday to visit the local chapter and also to attend the international convention of the Kiwanis club of which he is a member.

The Canadian Elks are desirous of bringing about social affiliation with the American order, Mr. Morris stated, and in fact have already extended such privileges to Elks from the United States visiting in Canada. By social affiliation, it was explained, is meant an interchange of clubroom privileges and other social privileges between members of the two orders. Affiliation along more complete lines is not desired by either the Canadian or the American orders, it was said.

Approval Is Voted.
At a meeting of the Portland organization last week, a resolution was passed authorizing the Portland delegates to the national convention in Chicago on July 3 to favor the social affiliation as sought by the Canadian order. Mr. Morris will be in Chicago at that time and will present the proposition to the convention.

The Canadian grand exalted ruler is a guest of Portland lodge, No. 142, by special invitation and is accompanied by his wife. Upon their arrival yesterday morning they were met by a special reception committee consisting of George G. Brandenburg, Monroe Goldstein, Harry G. Allen, Julius J. Berg and W. F. McKenny and were escorted to the Multnomah hotel where they will stay during their visit.

Banquet Is Tendered.
Last night a complimentary banquet was tendered Mr. Morris at the Benson hotel by the reception committee and officers of the Portland lodge and this evening the regular session of the lodge will be given over to an address by Mr. Morris. Mrs. Morris was entertained yesterday by Mrs. George Brandenburg and Mrs. Monroe Goldstein.

The Canadian Elks were organized in 1912 and have experienced a strong growth, Mr. Morris said. At the present time there are 48 lodges throughout the dominion. Mr. Morris was elected at the dominion session last September, and is due to serve as grand exalted ruler until the next annual dominion session in New Westminster, B. C., September 25.

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
