DOZEN MEMBERS OF APPRO-PRIATION GROUP DUE.

Men Who Control Funds for Projects to View Coast Work of Watering Deserts.

There will probably be 12 congressmen members of the delegation representing the appropriations committee that will visit irrigation projects and national parks of the coast in July. According to information received by the Portland Chamber of Commerce the party will begin their Oregon tour at Klamath Falls.
Stephen T. Mather, director of national park service, has mapped the trip by which the congressmen will see the highways and other improvements made at Crater lake, then pro-ceed via the highway through the Klamath Indian reservation and over the divide between the drainage of the Klamath and Deschutes to Bend. The pregramme for the entertain-ment and information of the committee in the section east of the mountains will be arranged at Bend and will probably include plans for having some of the irrigation projects of Deschutes and Jefferson counties. At Klamath Falls the chamber of commerce will charge of the entertainment. Parkhurst, manager of the hotel and transportation service at Crater lake, will have the preparations completed

The exact dates are not yet fixed, but probably the party will be at Klamath Fails July 8, Bend July 10 and will reach Portland and leave for Tacoma the night of July 11, devote two days to the Puget sound district and proceed to Yakima July 14.
