SUMMARY OF PRINCIPAL POINTS TOUCHED UPON IN DEMOCRATIC PLATFORM.

Women in Industry—Protection of child life through infancy salaries, legislation insuring American women (married to aliens) against child labor. Disarmed Soldiers—Party pledged to enactment of soldier settlement and home aid legislation. Railroads—Fair and complete test of private ownership and operation is advocated. Improved Highways—Continuance of federal aid plan is favored. American people congratulated on re-birth of merchant marine.

Port Facilities—Party pledged to stand for equality of rates, both import and export. Inland Waterways—Party favors liberal and comprehensive policy for the development and utilization of harbors and interior waterways. 
