

NERVE BLOCKING IN DENTISTRY IS SHOWN

Dr. A. E. Smith of Chicago Demonstrates at Clinic.

FREE CLINIC IS HELD

Lectures on Block Anesthesia Are Given at Convention of Oregon Dental Association.

Dr. Arthur E. Smith of Chicago yesterday gave a demonstration of painless dentistry at the 27th annual meeting of the Oregon State Dental Association. Dr. Smith gave post-graduate lectures on block anesthesia and oral surgery before the delegates at the North Pacific Dental college.

"There is no longer any excuse for a dentist causing pain," said Dr. Smith, and he proved his theory yesterday by extracting teeth for nearly 150 patients at a free clinic. He was assisted in the work by Dr. Howard Miller, also of Chicago.

No time was wasted in explaining how actually to pull the tooth or how to fill the cavity, but the demonstration was on Dr. Smith's method of nerve blocking during the time necessary to complete the work, so that the operation was painless to the patient.

Free Clinics Are Held.

Yesterday forenoon's programs consisted of the free clinics and classes for dentists. In the afternoon Dr. Lief Underdahl of Portland lectured on "Gold Dentures with Porcelain Facings." Dr. Lucio Stinson of Portland on "Care of Children's Teeth." Dr. Carey H. Jenkins of Hood River on "Gold Crowns and Bridges." Eugene Vaughn of Portland on "A New Inlay Investment."

There was no evening session, but Dr. Smith of Chicago, Dr. Weston A. Price of Cleveland, Dr. E. T. Tinker of Minneapolis and Dr. A. W. Ward of San Francisco were the principal speakers at an inter-fraternity banquet last night at the Benson hotel for the visiting dentists. Local chapters of Delta Sigma Delta, Psi Xi Phi and the Phi Omega, national dental fraternities, were the hosts of the banquet.

Wives of Portland and visiting dentists also were entertained at a dinner at the Benson with Mrs. Fred E. Gulick, Mrs. W. A. Shearer and Mrs. J. C. Jones in charge.

One of the interesting features of the convention which is attracting considerable attention is the display of dental supplies at the North Pacific college. The demonstrators are in charge of Dr. E. S. Sharpless, Dr. W. B. Lutz, Edwin Ostad, Dr. W. H. Ingraham, Dr. J. J. Welch, S. Badger, Dr. Harry Bonine, A. A. Hale and A. I. Klees.

Film to Be Viewed Today.

Today from 10 A. M. to 12 M. the dentists and members of the medical profession will view 5000 feet of film illustrating block anesthesia. These motion pictures will be shown by Dr. Arthur E. Smith of Chicago at the theater at Union avenue and Russell street, as the city fire ordinance will not permit the pictures to be shown at the college.

Free clinics and classes with Drs. Tinker, Ward and Smith will be held from 2 P. M. to 4 P. M. At 4 P. M. the general business session will elect officers for the ensuing year.

A trip will be taken by the dentists over the Columbia river highway tomorrow to Bonneville, where a picnic will be held.

PROHIBITION AIDS MOVIES

Hippodrome Manager Says Many New Theaters Are Being Opened.
