

POULTRY TEST SHOWS HIGH QUALITY

22 Supplying 95 to 100 Per Cent Rate Product.

WIFE SCORES HUSBAND

HIRAM JOHNSON IS CHARGED WITH PENUROUSNESS. Spouse Says He Withheld 23 Cents From Her Which She Earned. Seeks Divorce.

Unusual penuity is charged against Hiram A. Johnson, insurance man of Salem, in a divorce action filed in the Multnomah county circuit court yesterday by Mrs. Mary A. Johnson.

Twenty-two milk producers and distributors are supplying milk to Portland which tests between 95 and 100 per cent.

This was revealed in the announcement of standings of dairymen and inspectors issued yesterday by Dr. D. W. Mack, in charge of the milk division of the Portland health bureau, resulting from a milk test made on July 6.

Fifty-five dairymen and dealers, who are supplying milk to the city, are rated 95 points and but 19 with milk rating below 85 points.

The judges who handled the milk test were Dr. Mack, milk specialist of the bureau of animal industry, United States department of agriculture, and Professor B. Campbell, of the dairy division of the Oregon Agricultural college.

According to Dr. Mack, the labor situation has made it difficult for some of the dairymen to continue past high records. Some dairymen who were registered above 95 points are now rated about 90 points.

A vigorous campaign is being waged by Dr. Mack to maintain the high record which has always marked the milk supplied to the Portland district. Inspectors of the milk division are visiting dairymen, suggesting improvements, and are keeping a careful survey of the milk reaching Portland for distribution.

TACOMA TO REDUCE FARES

TRANSFERS TO COST PUBLIC 3 CENTS EACH. Passengers Pay 8 Cents to Reach Destination and 7 Cents to Get Back.

TACOMA, Wash., July 28.—(Special.)—Fares on the municipal street railway will be reduced to 5 cents August 1. Transfers to the Tacoma Railway & Power company lines from the municipal railway will be sold at 3 cents each.

This action was taken by the city council today when a resolution introduced by Commissioner Harrison was adopted unanimously.

The commissioners thought this agreement absurd, because it would cost a patron 8 cents to go to the Tidelands and 7 cents to return. No definite steps had been taken today looking to the operation of trolleys in competition with the street cars.

But little trouble was experienced in the transfer of passengers today, according to George W. Rounds, superintendent of the company.
