Troops Endeavor to Strengthen Bonds and Seek to Make Populace Friends of Soviet.

BERLIN, Aug. S.—soseph Roth wires to the New Berlin Gazette from Allenstein, East Prussia:

"Larger Bolzhevik forces have marched into Grajevo (close to the Polish-East Prussian frontier). A squadron of Bolshevik cavalry I saw on the border was well equipped; every man carried 250 cartriages in his belt. The leader, reserve officer and a student, assured me they have no intention to violate German territory.

"The Bolshevik cavalry is very good, but it has those diminutive horses which became so well known in the world war. Some of the cavairymen are Don Cossacks; some were the old-style Cossack uniforms, others modern field gray. The military discipline is of the old style; there is year much saluting.

cipline is of the old style; there is very much saluting.

"The Russians pay for everything they requisition in soviet ruble notes. They treat the population along the border well. In several towns the troops, as they entered, put up placards and proclamations reassuring the population. Among the army commanders is General Suchaczee.

commanders is General Suchaczee Skii, formerly a Czaristic First Lieutenant, now a socialist.

"Russian cavairy is visible along the entire border. They reassure the German border population again and again that they will respect the frontier. The rain of the last few days has somewhat slowed up the Russian army in its pursuit of the Poles. The troops know nothing of an armistice. troops know nothing of an armistice.
Their foed supply does not appear to
be especially good, and the soldiers
are hungry.
"In Allenstein there is an armed

camp of entente troops, who with-draw to this place. Apparently, the interallied officers do not know what to do. They were not prepared to leave the frontier, but were surprised by the unexpectedly rapid advance of the Bolsheviki and were forced to withdraw to Allenstein for fear of collisions with them.

"The first trainload of Polish refu-gees has arrived in West Prussia. Among them are the families of many officials; they will be interned. The poorer Polish population, unable to fice, awaits the arrival of the Bolshe-
