

PONZI TERMINATED TO FIGHT TO FINISH STATE BANKING COMMISSION STOPS PAYMENT ON CHECKS.

RECEIVER APPLIED FOR ITALIAN SAYS HE WILL DIE FIRST RATHER THAN REVEAL ASSETS TO ANYONE.

BOSTON, Aug. 9.—The response of Charles Ponzi, who claims to have made millions through dealing in international postal exchange, to bankruptcy proceedings brought against him, and to orders issued by the state bank commission today, founding the Hanover Trust company to cash checks signed by him or his agents, was his declaration tonight that he would not pay one cent of money at his office.

3 BILLION BUSHELS OF CORN PREDICTED

Crop Conditions in Nearly All States Improve.

WHEAT FORECAST IS CUT

Potato Yield Promises to Be One of Biggest Ever Gathered in United States.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 9.—A 3,000,000,000-bushel corn crop for the third time in history was forecast today by the department of agriculture on conditions existing August 1.

Improvement was reported during July in the important corn states. It is uncertain whether the crop forecast 23,000,000 bushels larger than that predicted July 1 was based on the fourth time in the country's history.

Spring wheat was adversely affected during July, principally by rust, and the forecast for the crop is 1,000,000,000 bushels, or 282,000,000 bushels less than that predicted July 1.

There was improvement in the potato crop and indications are that the crop will exceed 400,000,000 bushels for the fourth time in the country's history.

Tobacco has shown additional improvement and indications are that it will exceed the record crop of 1918 by about 200,000,000 pounds.

Production forecast was as follows: Winter wheat, 2,500,000,000; Spring wheat, 202,000,000; Corn, 3,000,000,000; Sorghum, 1,000,000,000; Barley, 190,000,000; Rye, 150,000,000; Buckwheat, 14,500,000; Sweet potatoes, 101,000,000; Tobacco (pounds), 1,100,000,000; Rice, 22,000,000; Cotton, 10,000,000; Hops, 18,000,000; Sugar, 1,000,000,000; Apples, total (bushels), 213,000,000; Peaches, 750,000,000; Peanuts, 28,700,000; Kaffirs, 100,000,000.

WASHINGTON ESTIMATES OUTLOOK FOR WHEAT LESS FAVORABLE THAN MONTH AGO.
