

WHOLE BUG RIVER NOW BATTLE LINE

Poles Recapture Positions Lost to Bolsheviks

HEAVY LOSSES INFLICTED

Armies Grouped About Warsaw for Defense of Capital Are Well Protected by Forts.

WARSAW, Aug. 16.—Uninterrupted fighting is going on in the valley of the Bug from its source to its confluence with the Narw.

Forces defending Warsaw are now grouped as follows: The left wing, resting on the fort of Modlin (Novo Georgivsk), holds the line of the lower Narw and Bug; the center, protected behind by the outer fort of Warsaw, occupies positions from 15 to 20 miles from the capital; the right wing commands the valley of the upper Bug.

Reds' Attacks Repulsed. In the center, on the lower Bug, all attacks delivered by the enemy to enable him to approach nearer the Warsaw forts, were repulsed with heavy losses.

Flotilla Watching River. An armored flotilla, starting from Warsaw and Thorn to prevent the bolsheviks from crossing to encircle this city. Many of these boats are armed with machine guns.

Poles Take Prisoners. The communistic reports successes for the Poles in the region of Cholm and Brubieszow, where the Poles took more than 100 prisoners, including the Russian chief of staff and much war material.

There is scarcely an American here now except a few

relief workers, officers of the American typhus expedition and newspaper correspondents. J. Pierpont Moffatt, third secretary at the American legation, is still here looking after the interests of the United States government. Slightly wounded Polish soldiers have also gone to Posen.

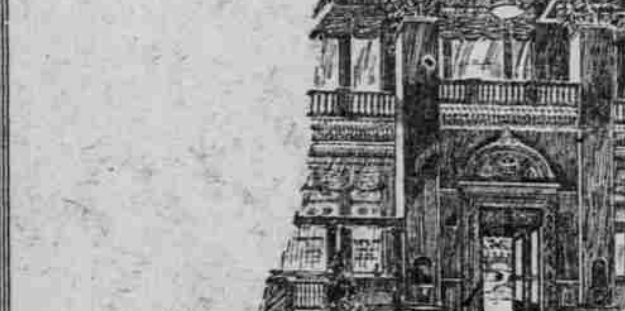
