SAVES \$208,500

6250 ACRES OF GRASSHOPPERS KILLED IN IDAHO.

More Than 40 School Districts Which Ravages Crops.

GRANGEVILLE, Idaho, Sept. 5-(Special) - Grasshoppers were measured by the acre in Idaho county this mated to have saved the farmers \$325,373 on their crops. More than 40 school districts were organized to fight the pest and 27 grasshopper meetings were held in two months with an attendance of 600 farmers.

Enough poisoned bran mash was mixed to cover 6250 acres. There were 2085 acres covered three times, the grasshoppers being completely ex

the grasshoppers being completely ex-terminated each time. As it was known that an acre of grasshoppers would destroy ten acres of grain, hay or garden truck, the acreage of crops saved from ruin was computed at 20 850

Estimating the average value of crops at only \$10 an acre, the gross saving was \$208,500. The cost of getting the bran mash to the farmers, who co-operated with the farm bu-reau, was \$3121. Expenditure of time by farmers in mixing and distribut-ing the poison was not estimated.


