BIRD BILL OPPOSED

Willamette Valley Committee Visits Malheur Lake.

CAUTION URGED ON VOTERS

Land If Once Ceded to the Government Will Be Lost to State for Good, It Is Declared.

BURNS, Or., Sept. 28 .- (Special.)-When a committee of Willamette valley business men was in Burns recently for the purpose of investigating the transportation problem of central Oregon, a trip was made to Malheur lake to obtain information pertaining to the proposed bird refuge
bill which is to come before the voters
at the general election in November.
After an examination of conditions
the members of the committee pledged
themselves to oppose the bill. They
declared they felt, as the residents of
Harney and adjoining counties do,
that the land, once ceded to the government, will lose to the state thousands of dollars for the school fund.
Although the land is classified as
swamp land, it was found to be largely agricultural, and not as the general conception is said to be that it is
all covered by water.
