

AUTO TIRE PRICES CUT 7 TO 15 PER CENT

Number of Leading Makes Are Reduced.

OVERSUPPLY IS BLAMED

Decrease Is From 7 1/2 to 10 Per Cent on Cords and 10 to 15 Per Cent on Fabrics.

Automobile tires are cheaper this week by all the way from 7 1/2 to 15 per cent, as the result of reductions by a number of the leading manufacturers...

The drop on the average is from 7 1/2 to 10 per cent on cord tires and from 10 to 15 per cent on fabrics, with a reduction of around 10 per cent on tubes and solids also.

Cut Begun Two Weeks Ago. The United States Rubber company began the reduction movement with an announcement about two weeks ago...

Since that time a number of the other larger manufacturers have fallen in line. Among those which have made reductions are Fisk, which has announced a lowering of 7 1/2 per cent for cords...

Goodyear Last to Join. Among the latest of the big concerns to join the ranks of the reducers is the Goodyear Rubber company. On Monday Goodyear announced a drop of 7 1/2 per cent on cords...

Several of the companies have made no announcements yet regarding reductions, or at least no word has reached local distributors...

Should Mother of Abandoned Infant Be Not Located, Baby Will Get Good Care and Rearing.

Mary Lou, infant waif who was left at the home of Mrs. Mary Lawrence last week, is assured of a good, comfortable home. Even though her mother, whom the police are seeking, never appears to claim her daughter, the little Miss is going to grow up and prosper.

Such was the edict yesterday of Chief of Police Jenkins, in whose home Mary Lou has been staying since she was first found.

They have become so attached to her that she has to give her up, said the chief yesterday. "In fact, if we are unable to locate the mother, we have decided to adopt her as our own child."

Despite the attachment which Chief and Mrs. Jenkins have for the infant, they are still making a determined effort to locate the mother.

The chief has detailed two detectives from the police bureau to prosecute a thorough investigation, but thus far they have been unable to find any trace of her.

Mrs. Jenkins had Mary Lou at police headquarters again yesterday afternoon and all the officers stationed there have become deeply attached to the bright-eyed little baby who appears to be happy and contented in her new home.
