DECK CARGO LOST, SVEA HEADS SOUTH

Schooner Buffeted by Breakers on Coos Bay.

DAMAGE BELIEVED SLIGHT

Vessel Makes Best Fight in Narrow Channel Ever Seen by Coast Guard.

MARSHFIELD, Or., Dec. 19.—(Special.)—In attempting to go to sea last evening across the Coos bay bar, which had been declared impassable all day with constant breakers running its length, the steam schooner Svea was thrust upon the south spit and afterward on the north spit, and her entire deck of lumber lost.

Lights Disappear at 9.

It was dusk when the vessel first struck and soon after the coast guard could not determine her condition. About 9 o'clock her lights disappeared and it was concluded she had not been seriously damaged. It was believed the Svea would stay about until morning and return to port, but she rigged up her deck and proceeded southward during the night, making fair headway, as later reported here.

Entire Deck Load Lost.

The Svea had a lumber cargo from the Bay Park sawmill, North Bend. On the south spit she lost a large amount of her deckload and pulled off with a heavy starboard list. Getting into the channel, the Svea was buffeted by the force of several breakers and went on the north spit in a few minutes. The remainder of the deckload was quickly washed overboard, the vessel righted, backed into the channel again and steamed out to sea.

Complete Confession Made.
