Songs and Noise Mark Last
Moments in House.

RING IS GIVEN RITNER

Senators Present Valuable Gift to
Presiding Officer and Sev-
eral Make Speeches.

STATE HOUSE, Salem, Or., Feb. 23.—(Special.)—In the house bellum broke loose shortly after 2 o'clock this afternoon and for the next hour the legislators were entertained with a series of songs, jokes and other entertainment features. Among the self-styled vocalists who made their presence known as the session drew to a close were Representative Knibbl of Multnomah county, James Stewart, (former member of the legislature, and others more humble in legislative circles. "How dry I am seemed to be the most popular rendition. While the swan song was being sung in the house the senate listened to an address by Senator Dennis, at the conclusion of which he presented a beautiful ring to President Ritner. This ring, which bears an engraving of the capitol set in diamonds, was the gift of members of the senate, stenographers, clerks and other attaches of the upper house.

Valuable Service Recounted. In his presentation address Senator Dennis said the man who presided over the senate during the session of the legislature just drawing to a close was born in eastern Oregon and had all the traits of those sturdy men whose accomplishments would ever stand as a monument to their untiring activities. "Senator Ritner was reared the same as other boys," said Senator Dennis. "He received the same punishment for his mischievous acts as did the other boys of his day, but he has lived to realize his attainments as president of this senate. He has acted honestly, courageously and in the best interests of the people he represents.

"I hope this man of whom I speak some day, with the retirement of the representative in congress from the eastern Oregon district, may be elected to fill that office and may represent our people in the halls of the United States congress. A better recollection would be to have the name of Senator Dennis on the roll of the United States congress."

Faithless Declared Ambitious. In responding, President Ritner said he always would cherish the gift and that in future years he would recall with satisfaction and pleasure the brief time he presided over the state senate. "I have endeavored to be fair in all my dealings with this senate," he said, "but like every man, I have made mistakes. I wish to assure you, however, that these mistakes were of the head and not of the heart. In conclusion, I wish you all happiness and the greatest possible prosperity."

Little later Senator Moser, acting in behalf of the members of the senate, spoke of the three pages who served the upper house so faithfully and efficiently during the legislative session. In conclusion he presented these employes with some silver, for which they returned their oral appreciation. Restrictions under the senate rule, making it impossible for him to retaliate, Senator Joseph took his medicine and smiled.

Other equally entertaining stunts helped to amuse the legislators and spectators as the upper house marked the closing hours of the session. Senator Joseph during the late legislative session for failing to report more promptly on the so-called straight party ballot. He also introduced a measure for the annexation of a part of Clackamas county to Multnomah county.

Senators Ryan and Joseph denied any knowledge of the bill Senator Moser then charged the senate committee of counties, had purposely and in violation of the legislative rules taken the measure to Portland. Because of this he demanded that the records of the senate show that the bill had not been returned to the legislators, and was in the possession of Senator Hume, who had returned to his home in Portland. No action was taken by the senate.

WASHINGTON SOLONS

STATE HOUSE, Salem, Or., Feb. 23.—(Special.)—The senate this afternoon laid on the table a bill approved by both branches of the legislature providing for a change in the personnel of the emergency board, and later vetoed by Governor Olcott.

HOUSE IN STORMY SESSION

The house today had a stormy session over the Beeler anti-alien land bill, when Representative Houser of Polk county introduced a motion that the house resolve itself into a committee of the whole to consider further information on the measure.

Houser declared the members were being asked to give in to men who were being paid Jap money to oppose the measure. Mark Reed of Mason, floor leader, resented the insinuation made by Houser and declared the statement unfair to every member of the house.

Attempt to Kill Bill, Plain.

Houser contended that the motion to put the bill into committee of the whole was an attempt to kill the bill.

Salary Bill Voted Down.

With a dozen members attacking the Murray bill proposing an increase of \$5 a day for expenses of the legislators in attending the session as a salary grab measure, the house voted down the measure.

Animals Must Be Tested.

Representatives Nash, Hufford and Lucas were appointed on a conference committee to report on a bill making it unlawful to exhibit any bovine animal at any fair or exhibition of livestock unless the animal had been subjected to a tuberculin test under the provision of a bill introduced in the senate by Lamaker of Whatcom.

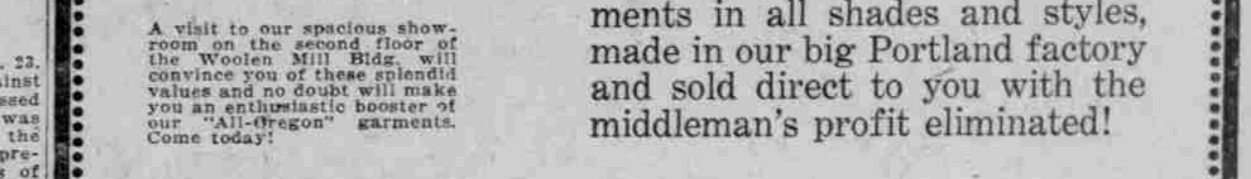
