

COURTESY MAY CURB OR LAW OFFENDERS

Aid in Enforcing Prohibition Held Authorized.

SEARCH PROVISIONS CITED

Attorney-General in Opinion Asked by Governor Submits Exhaustive Discussion of Law.

SALEM, Or., May 20.—(Special)—County courts have authority to contract with private law enforcement agencies operating independently of authorized peace officers for the enforcement of state prohibition laws and to expend county funds in payment for services rendered under such contracts, according to I. H. Van Winkle, attorney-general.

Suspicion Not Permitted

Whether the officer invoking the provisions of this statute has personal knowledge of the crime alleged is a matter for the court to determine.

Does the state prohibition law provide that officers may search premises on public highways or in public places for liquor without specific warrants?

It is the opinion of this office that peace officers or other persons have no right to search premises on public highways or in public places without specific warrants.

Confiscation Issue Raised.

Does the state prohibition law provide that officers may confiscate liquor found on premises, public highways, in search conducted without warrant?

Receipt Should Be Given.

Does the state prohibition law provide that officers may confiscate liquor as evidence of violation of the prohibition law without giving a receipt for the same?
