These hulls are of wood construction of the Ferris 3100 DWT and Hough 4000 DWT types. This type of hull has been extensively converted into five-masted barkentines, schooners and low barges and have given excellent service in the transportation of bulk cargoes such as lumber, petroleum, minerals and general cargo in coastwise and trans-oceanic trade.

These hulls are built to the requirements of American Bureau of Shipping and the British Lloyd's Register.
