Oregon Senator Telephones White House About Matter, but President Is Out.

Portland to Fight Philadelphia's Claim to Exposition. A fight to obtain federal recognition of the proposed 1925 exposition was started yesterday by fair, chamber of commerce and civic officials...

Square Deal Asked. On receipt of advice of the activities for the withholding of federal approval of the western exposition...

The Portland exposition has already received the approval of the United States senate, which adopted a resolution inviting foreign cooperation...

Federal Approval Asked. "The president," Mr. Meier said yesterday, "certainly could not put a stop to the holding of the proposed Portland exposition..."

The San Francisco fair had practically no foreign participation owing to the war. However, by 1925 we anticipate that the nations of the world will be so far recovered from the effects of the war that they will be able and willing to co-operate in the proposed world's exposition...

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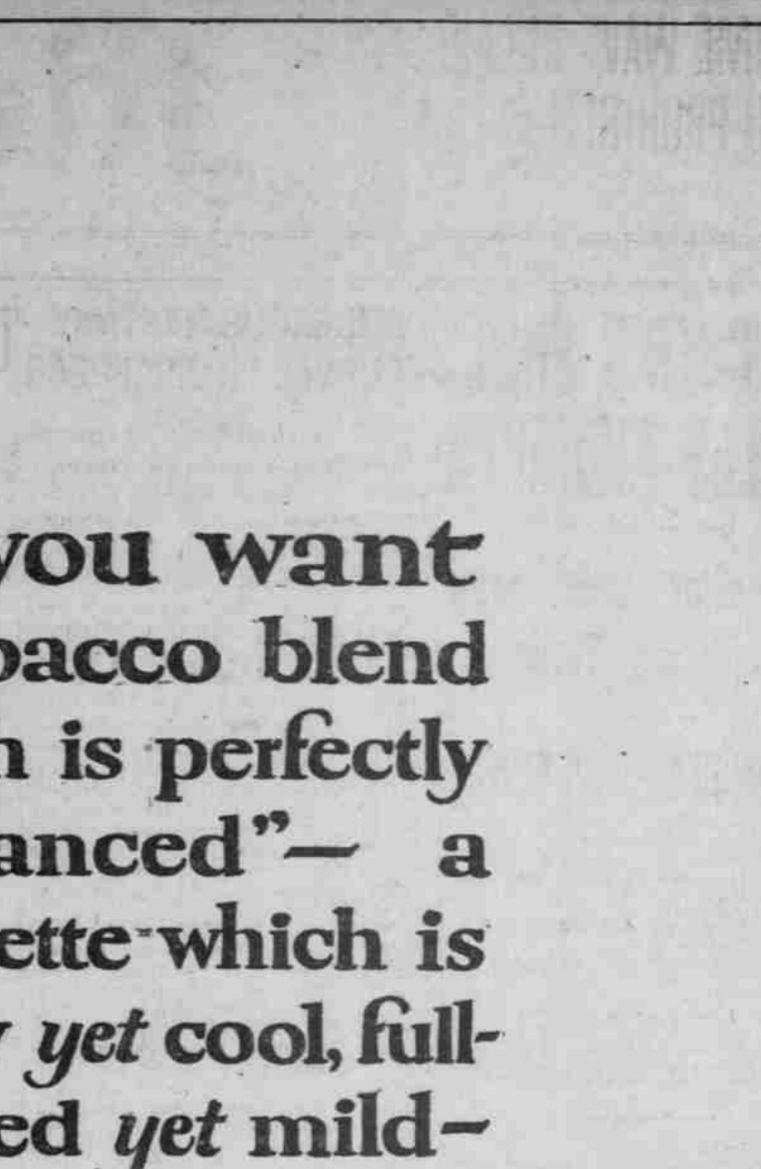
