

BALFOUR EXPECTED TO BE DELEGATE

Lloyd George inclined to Visit America in Person.

DISARMING BIG TOPIC

Interest is Divided With Irish Peace Conference—Next Move by United States Awaited.

LONDON, July 12.—(By the Associated Press.) The disarmament conference continues to be the most prominent topic of discussion, dividing honors with the Irish peace conference.

It is assumed as a certainty that A. J. Balfour, lord president of the council, will be a delegate, and probably also Admiral Lord Beatty, Lord Lee of Frenham, first lord of the admiralty, and Sir Laming Worthington Evans, secretary for war.

Much interest is shown in the question as to whether Germany and Russia will be invited to send delegates, and in the press comment increasing attention is bestowed on the fact that the invitations are not confined to those powers especially interested in Pacific problems.

New General Meeting Waited. The premier's statement in the house of commons yesterday, welcoming President Harding's suggestion for a conference to discuss the limitation of armaments, probably will be the only announcement of the attitude of Great Britain on the subject until Washington announces the exact nature of proceedings for organization of the conference.

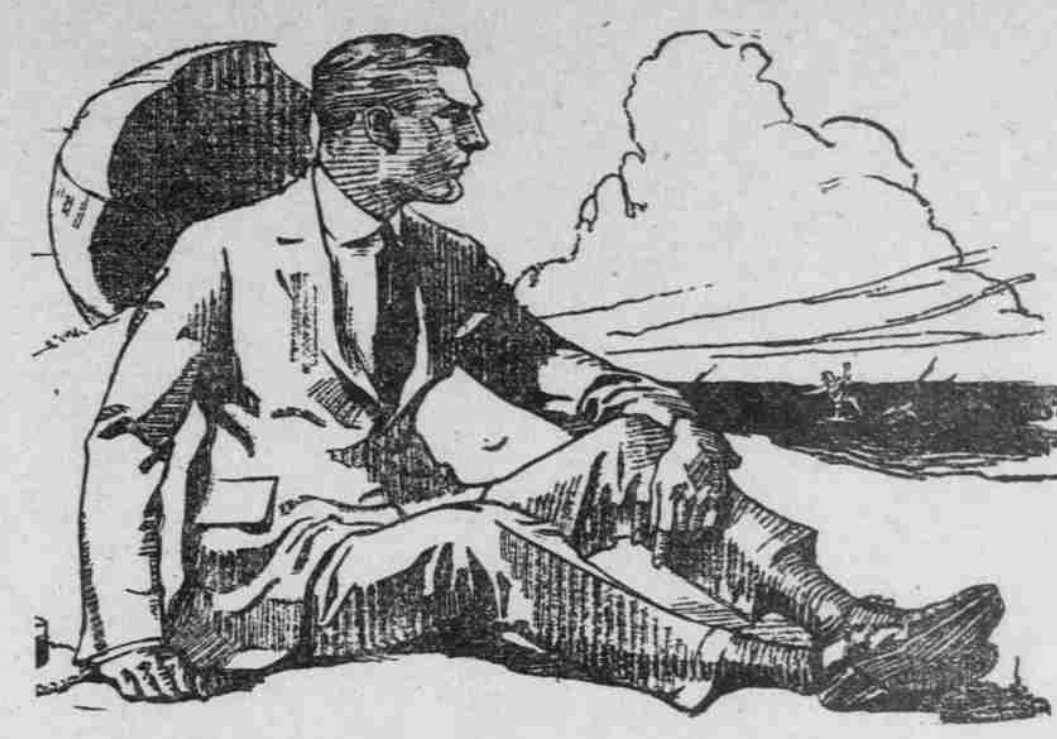
