The capital stock tax is a special excise tax imposed on corporations with respect to "carrying on or doing business." The tax on domestic corporations is \$1 for each \$1000 or so much of the fair average value of its capital stock for the preceding year ending June 30 as is in excess of \$5000. Foreign corporations are required to pay a tax at the rate of \$1 for each \$1000 of their capital employed in the transaction of business in the United States without the benefit of the \$5000 reduction. The tax is payable in advance, returns filed in July of this year obverting the taxable year, beginning July 1, 1921, and ending June 30, 1921.

The bureau of internal revenue estimates that approximately \$25,000 such returns will be approximately \$00,000,000.
