

ANKENY HILL DETOUR, SOUTH OF SALEM NOW ELIMINATED

Condition of Highways Throughout Oregon Is Shown in Summary Issued by State Highway Commission.

SALEM, Or., Aug. 11.—(Special.)—The Ankeny hill detour on the route of the Pacific highway, a few miles south of Salem, has been eliminated according to announcement made today at the office of the state highway department.

Tourists en route south are now advised to proceed out Commercial street from Salem for a distance of approximately five miles, then following the signs to Sunnyside school, and from there over the newly completed concrete pavement to Albany.

The road between Salem and Albany, via Independence and Buena Vista, is now paved, and the detour route south of Salem is to be in first-class condition. Travelers are advised to observe the signs on the detour south of Salem (Rosedale road), especially in passing cars, to avoid confusion.

Roseburg-Cook Bay Highway—Cook Bay Work—Under construction, starting at south city limits of Albany, to the right, following signs via the east side of Albany, to Cook Bay.

Corvallis-Waldport—Road good from Corvallis to Philomath and from there to Waldport. Beyond Waldport, road is in fair condition.

The Dalles-California Highway—The Dalles-Madras—Road in fair shape through DuPont, Madras, or Clifton. Madras-Crooked River—New crushed rock road, under construction.

John Day Highway—Arlington-Centerville—Road by Shuter and Olex badly rutted by wheat hauling and dust. Fair except five miles being under construction.
