

BACON TO BE SENT TO EUROPE BY SEA Dutch Steamer Will Load Oregon Meat Cargo.

SHIPMENT IS 131 TONS Consignment Goes in Refrigeration and Is First of Kind Sent by All-Water Route.

The first direct shipment of meat from Portland to Europe by refrigerated steamer will begin this morning at municipal terminal No. 4 when the Dutch steamer Meerdijk of the Holland-American line takes aboard 131 tons of Oregon bacon.

SHIPMENT TAKES ALL SPACE Coming from the cold storage houses of Swift & Co. at Kenton, the bacon will be loaded into six refrigerated cars and transferred directly from the cars to the refrigerated holds of the steamer.

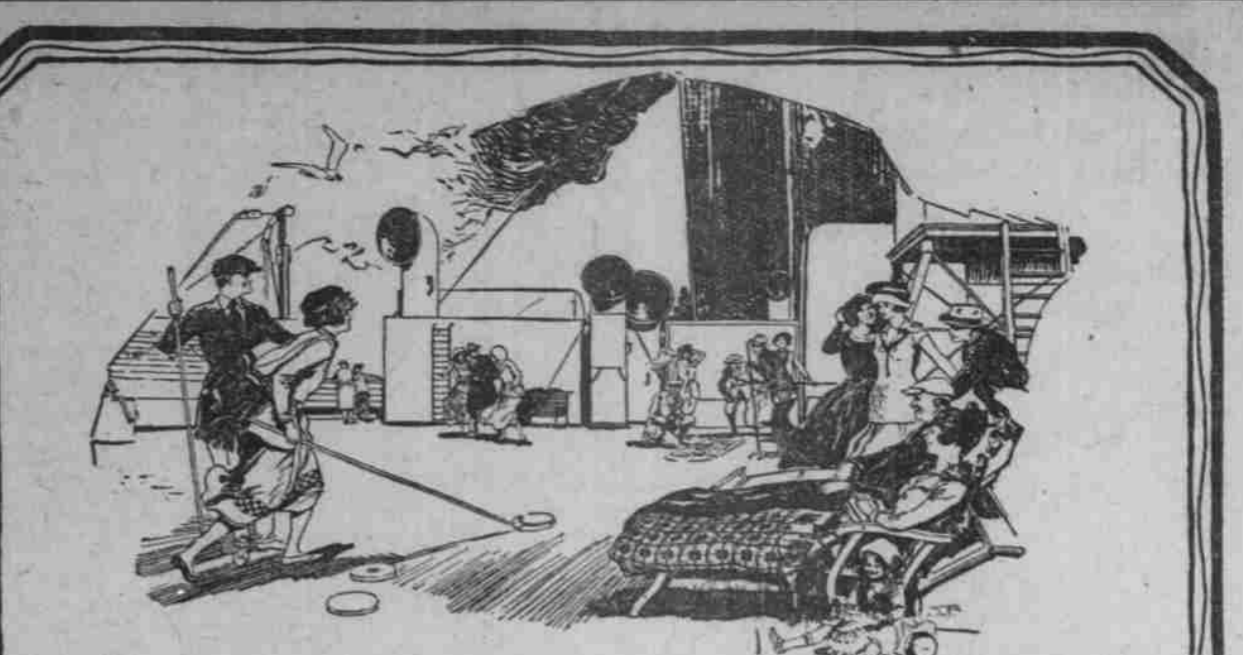
