

PEPPERMINT GROWN ON CRANBERRY SOIL

New Use Found for Muck Land in Washington.

RESULTS ARE GRATIFYING

Big Problem of Hard Labor is Eliminated, Declare Two Portland Men Making Trial.

A new use for the muck land of Pacific country, Washington, near Long Beach, has been discovered by Dr. C. F. Lauderdale and George H. Wells, two Portland men.

The peppermint produces for about six years on the muck land, where the soil has been planted. The Portland men have established a distilling plant, where the oil is now being extracted.

The peppermint is harvested a great deal like a hay crop. The mowers used and the plants are raked and allowed to cure in the sun.

Planting Runners Laborious. The raising of the peppermint on muck land is entirely new to the valley, declared Dr. Lauderdale.

Planting of the runners is a laborious task, as it is almost necessary to do this by hand, and the work retards the speed.

Hand weeding is necessary during the early stages. When the plants finally bloom, which is about the middle of August on the farm, the mowers get in their work.

The after-work from the oil extractor process is plowed under after the frost, being covered to about five inches deep.

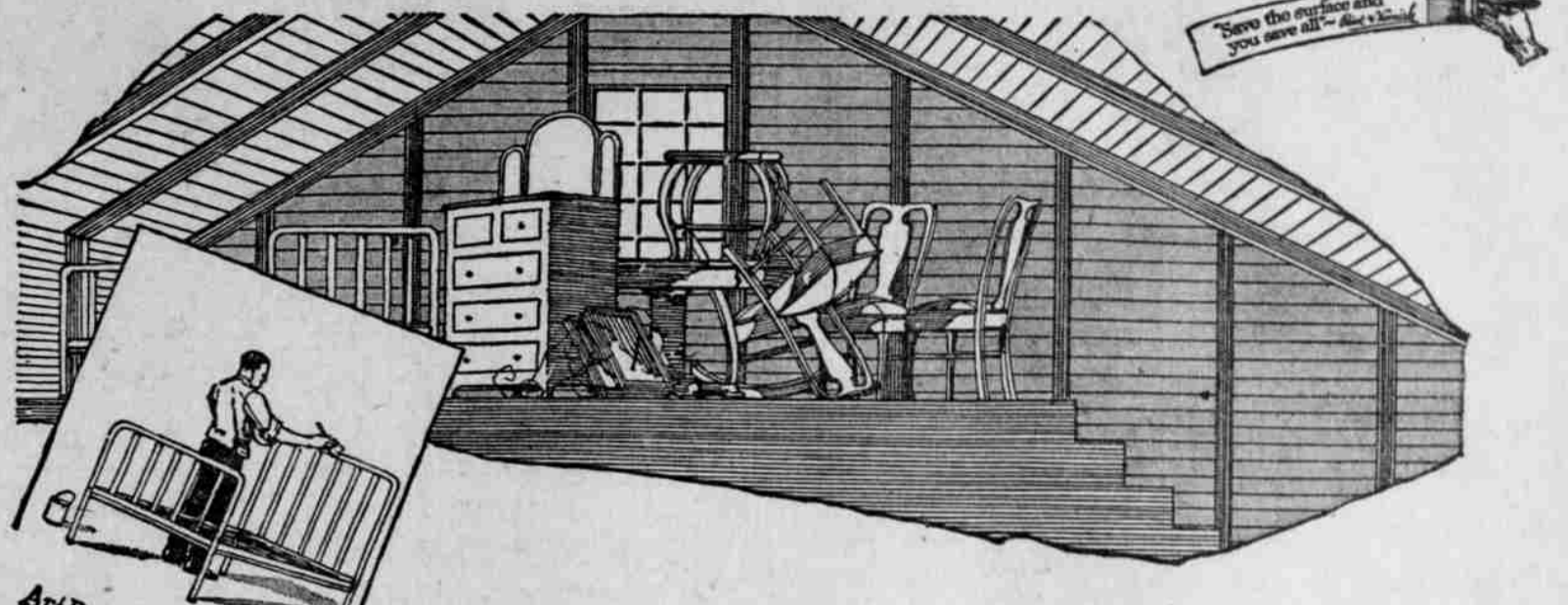
