

LARGE MOVEMENT OF HAY ASSURED

Produce to Go From Oregon to Atlantic Coast. DOCK PREPARATIONS MADE

Tentative Rate of \$1.10 a Ton Set by Commission - Warehouse Provided at Terminal No. 1.

A large movement of hay from Oregon to the Atlantic coast is assured for the immediate future. John H. Burgard, chairman of the commission of docks, told the other commissioners at a meeting of the body yesterday morning.

Mr. Burgard said that if satisfactory arrangements can be made, the hay movement to the Atlantic coast will amount to about 12,000 tons this season.

Because hay is such a bulky commodity in comparison with its weight, it is expected that not more than 150 or 200 tons of hay will be taken by the coast-to-coast trade.

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LINE GETS NEW VESSELS

PACIFIC CARIBBEAN GULF CO. ADDS TO FLEET. Scheduled to Come to Coast in Near Future.

The Pacific Caribbean Gulf line, which has been operated by Swayne & Hoyt of San Francisco with shipping board steamers, is to be augmented by the addition of several privately owned steamers of the Moore & McCormack company of New York.
