INSTRUMENTS THROWN OUT

Shock of Great Intensity Recorded at Washington, D. C.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Jan. 31.—

An earthquake of great intensity, probably 2500 to 2600 miles south of Washington, D. C., was recorded early today at the Georgetown seismological observatory.

SEATTLE SHOCK PRONOUNCED

Center Believed Several Thousand Miles South of City.

SEATTLE, Wash., Jan. 31.—

A pronounced earthquake shock, centering probably several thousand miles in a southerly direction from Seattle, was recorded at the seismological observatory of Washington here today.

SPOKANE, Wash., Jan. 31.—

Earthquake shocks emanating, it was reckoned, from a point 700 miles southeast of this city, were recorded by the seismological observatory today.

ORIGIN THOUGHT IN PACIFIC

Disturbance Believed Probably Off Columbia River.

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Jan. 31.—

The earthquake which rattled all parts of the United States today probably occurred under the Pacific ocean off the coast of Washington or Oregon, it was said after thorough reckoning at Harvard university today.

DENVER ALSO RECORDS QUAKE

Most Severe Shock in 15 Years Is Registered by Seismograph.

DENVER, Jan. 31.—

The seismograph at Regis college here today registered the most severe earthquake recorded in the last 15 years, according to Father Forestall.

SHANTUNG ISSUE SETTLED

WASHINGTON, D. C., Jan. 31.—

Preparations to present publicly the five-power naval and submarine treaties at tomorrow's open session of the arms conference were completed today.

Protocol to Cover Submarines.

Chinese to Manage Road.
