FIRE BUREAU CASE STILL HANGS FIRE

Penalty for Detractors of Chief Undecided.

COUNCIL STUDIES RECORD

Commissioner Bigelow Wants to Go Over Transcript of Testimony Before Decision.

Although John E. Young, chief of the Portland fire bureau, was exonerated completely of all charges brought against him by a group of disgruntled firemen last Saturday City Commissioner Bigelow, in charge

City Commissioner Bigelow, in charge of the fire bureau, as yet has taken no steps to penalize the men who brought about the turmoil in the department or to give Chief Young complete charge of the bureau.

When questioned as to the developments in the case yesterday, Commissioner Bigelow stated that he had not yet obtained a transcript of the evidence in the case, but that he expected to have a copy of the testimony on his desk in a day or two.

Case to Be Studied.

"I do not feel like making any move until I have gone over this testimony carefully," said Commissioner Higelow.

Other members of the city council are of one mind in regard to steps that should be taken in the fire

steps that should be taken in the fire bureau. These members have freely expressed themselves in favor of placing the fire bureau under the direct supervision of the fire chief, including the fire marshal's office, and holding the fire chief responsible for the conduct of the bureau. "I had my experience in the police bureau," said Mayor Baker yesterday. "I did not get results in that bureau until I adopted the definite policy of making the chief of the police department chief in every way. Now no member of the bureau comes to my office unless sent to me by the chief. And all matters are by the chief. And all matters are referred to the chief at all times.

Plan Declared Only One. Plan Declared Only One.

"I know from experience that this is the only plan that will work in either the police or the fire bureau and I am certain that Commissioner Bigelow, after making a thorough investigation of the affair, will come to this conclusion and make his changes in the department make his changes in the department accordingly."

Experienced firemen in the bureau Experienced firemen in the bureau declare that the morale throughout the various districts of the fire department has improved materially since the vindication of Chief Young. The general feeling among the men of the fire bureau that hereafter Chief Young will be the commander-in-chief of the bureau has put a stop to much rumbling that came to the city hall by the "grapevine" route during past months.

Prior to the filing of charges

during past months.

Prior to the filing of charges against Chief Young and his subsequent acquittal, it was the habit of men of various ranks in the bureau to deal directly with Commissioner Bigelow instead of sending all matters through the fire chief, but since the hearing of last week, the members of the bureau have been giving Commissioner Bigelow's office a wide berth.

If Commissioner Bigelow follows the vindleation of Chief Young with drastic measures favored by other members of the fire bureau, it is believed that the Portland fire bureau will soon be back on a high standard with all members striving for the highest mark of efficiency.

An interesting programme, consisting largely of addresses, but concluding with the showing of motion pictures, was presented. The speakers included Mayor Baker, Chairman Newill of the school board, Superintendent of Schools Grout, Fire Marshal Grenfel and B. F. president of the National Safety council,


Prominence was given the safety pledge, which was originated in Portland and is said already to have been adopted in many other cities. The pledge is this:

The work of the junior safety council for the past year was reviewed. During the past 12 months it was said there had been 72 accidents to school children, three of which were fatal.


