SEAWALL IS PROPOSED

Astoria Project Is Designed to Enable Street Improvement.

ASTORIA, Or., Oct. 5.—(Special).—At a recent meeting of the West End Development league, a committee consisting of Fred Schmidt, F. Kankkonen, Sven Lonberg, G. A. Hellberg and J. Kiske was appointed to request the sanitary and reclamation commission to construct a seawall or bulkhead along the city waterfront, in the western section of the city, and make a fill by pumping sand from the river channel, so that Taylor avenue from the foot of the hill to the port docks can be improved by paving.

The cost of the project would be about \$500,000, the segregation being \$200,000 for the bulkhead and \$300,000 for the fill.
