

\$115,500 ASKED FOR COUNTY HOSPITAL

Fund Held Needed to Complete Building.

OPERATION IS SEPARATE

Construction of Nurses' Home in Connection With Institution Held Necessary.

To complete the new county hospital, for which appropriations aggregating \$1,500,000 have already been made, it has been asked that an additional \$115,500 be appropriated for 1934, it developed yesterday at the hearing before the tax supervision and conservation commission.

The budget, transmitted to the commission, called for \$110,000. F. W. Mulkey, chairman of the commission, immediately called attention to the fact that architects' fees had not been included. H. A. Whitney, representing the firm of Saitman & Whitney, architects, was present and declared that the fees should be added.

The \$115,500 sought to complete the building has nothing to do with operation of the institution. It was said at the hearing that the structure should be finished and ready for occupancy by May 1, 1935. The operating budget will be presented and will be considered at a date yet to be announced by the tax supervision body.

Budget Items Are Given.

The budget items requested for completion of the hospital building were as follows:

One line of questioning pursued by Chairman Mulkey was directed particularly at future costs of the hospital as a whole. He asked questions brought from Dr. H. R. Cliff, county physician, the statement that a new nurses' home should be planned in connection with the hospital.

Building Needed by 1934.

Erection of such a home should be considered necessary not later than 1934, said Dr. Cliff. He said Mulkey wanted to know how much of a building this would be. He said it would be as large as the new nurses' home at Good Samaritan hospital. The answers of Dr. Cliff and county commissioners were that it would probably need to be that large. This would mean a construction cost of somewhere between \$150,000 and \$200,000, estimated Chairman Mulkey.

Dr. Cliff was questioned also with reference to completion of the projected additional wing. This, said the doctor, would normally be completed in five years. Its cost, he said, would be around \$200,000 or \$225,000, but it would double the capacity of the institution.

Equipment Needs Explained.

Miss Emma E. Jones, superintendent of the hospital, was present and gave explanation of the budget for \$17,338 she had requested for construction of the new nurses' home. She said it was needed to cover cost of new equipment and fixtures, together with proper renovation of old equipment which the move is made to the new hospital.

At 10 o'clock this morning the tax commission will hold its third hearing of the week, considering items of the county road budget. It was announced that the joint commission which attempts to reconcile the public welfare bureau's budget and plans for 1934 will be made, has been set for next Monday at 2 P. M.

FARMERS FOR RATE CUT

Opposition by Montana Millers Not Shared by Growers.

HELENA, Mont., Oct. 12.—Opposition by the millers of Montana to the 7-cent cut in the freight rate from Montana points on wheat intended for export to the Orient is not shared by farmers of the state, according to communications received here by the state railroad commission and Commissioner of Agriculture Dennis.

Request for suspension of the lowered rate has been made by the railroad commission to the interstate commerce commission on the grounds that it will enable coast mills to deprive Montana flour mills of their market, thereby injuring both mills and growers.

Consideration will be given by the state commission at its next meeting to asking the interstate commerce commission to grant the reduction on the domestic route on wheat, as well as on wheat intended for shipment across the Pacific, according to Chairman Dennis.

RIFLE SCARES "GORILLA"

Glenwood Woman Escapes From Man and Gets Weapon.

SEATTLE, Wash., Oct. 12.—Mrs. A. Pleser, living at Glenwood, 20 miles southwest of here across Puget sound, today reported an attack made upon her by a stranger, who knocked at the door last night while her husband was away. Three similar attacks have recently been made at Olympia.

Mrs. Pleser said that the man clutched her in his arms while she pounded his face with her fists and screamed for help. Six hundred feet unheeded, but she got free in the struggle, she relates, and ran into the next room and seized her husband's rifle. When she returned to the man, he fled. Mrs. Pleser found his wife standing guard at the gate.

ROAD BOOSTERS FORMED

Highway From Pendleton to Lakeview to Be Backed.

PENDLETON, Or., Oct. 12.—(Special.)—Preliminary organization of a road association which has for its purpose the boosting of a north and south highway from Pendleton to Lakeview, was effected yesterday afternoon when James Moffie of Ukiah was elected president of the association. The association will have its first meeting at Pendleton, Oct. 13, at 2 P. M.

ROAD SURVEY IS BEGUN

State and County to Split Cost of Goshen-Lowell Project.

EUGENE, Or., Oct. 12.—(Special.)—The survey of the Goshen-Lowell road, which is a portion of the upper Willamette state highway and which is designated as Lane county road bond project No. 14, was started today by W. N. Pendleton, engineer for the state highway commission, who arrived in Eugene yesterday from Coquille, where he has been engaged in similar work.

The state and Lane county will split the cost "50-50," and it is expected that construction will be started early next spring. While the distance between Goshen and Lowell is about 15 miles, there will be but 12 miles of construction, as a portion of the route has already been macadamized.

ANTI-KLAN MAN TO RUN

Umatilla Treasurer Accepts Independent Nomination.

PENDLETON, Or., Oct. 12.—(Special.)—C. K. Cranston, treasurer of Umatilla county, filling the independent ticket of Miss Grace Gilliam, and who was defeated by H. H. DeHart, endorsed by the Ku Klux Klan, yesterday announced his acceptance of a nominating petition signed by 300 leading Republicans and Democrats naming him as the independent candidate for the office.

County Clerk Brown, who is certifying the petitions for the ballots, stated yesterday that he could not refuse to place Cranston's name on the ballot, but he is in decision on the recent ruling of the secretary of state.

LANE VALUATION GROWS

Assessor's Figures Show Gain of Nearly \$1,000,000.

EUGENE, Or., Oct. 12.—(Special.)—The assessed valuation of property in Lane county this year, exclusive of that of the public service corporations, is nearly \$1,000,000 greater than that of last year, according to Herbert E. Walker, assessor, who yesterday made public the county's assessment figures. The valuation this year, aside from that to be placed on public service property, is \$1,556,354, an increase of \$1,000,000 over last year, an increase of \$525,124.

The amount exempted this year on account of the state law allowing \$1000 exemption for veterans of the civil war or their widows is \$154,270.

PRICE OF SUGAR JUMPS

Wholesalers at Astoria Raise Figure 15 Cents.

ASTORIA, Or., Oct. 12.—(Special.)—The wholesale price of sugar took another jump this morning of 15 cents a hundred, making the local price \$7.50 a hundred for No. 12, although Astoria wholesalers are holding to the former price of \$7.35 for the present.

A barrel of sugar, which has dropped 20 cents a barrel, but advice received said that decline was unwarranted, having been caused by certain Puget sound mills cutting prices. They said the market is so strong that prices are due to not drop, but to advance another 40 cents, making a total jump of 60 cents a barrel.

SOCIAL WORKERS QUIT

Astoria Civic Center Commission Decides to Resign.

ASTORIA, Or., Oct. 12.—(Special.)—As a result of Astoria's having adopted a managerial form of government, the Astoria Civic Center Commission, which was created to direct the affairs of all branches of the municipal government, has decided to resign.

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WATER VOTE IS DELAYED

Proposal for Hood River System Too Late for Ballot.

THE DALLIES, Or., Oct. 12.—(Special.)—The proposal placed on the ballot for November 7, to improve the Hood River water supply, will be omitted from the ballot. Stephens & Koon of Portland, who are doing the preliminary work on the bill, said the proposal, have not yet completed their examination and will be unable to finish the work by the time the ballot is prepared.

An election will be held, however, at a later date, and it is believed that the members of the committee will be able to finish the work by the time the ballot is prepared.
