Bishop McKinney Returns - Nat'l Meet

Bishop Mrs. W. L. McKinney, Administrative Asst. Bishop and Mrs. H.B. Daniels, the Women's Dept. Supervisor, Mrs. Eulah Williams, and other Cabinet Members, of the churches of God in Christ, Inc. of Oregon attend the 63rd Holy Convocation in Memphis, Tenn., Nov. 3-12, 1970 with 15,000 other delegates from all over the world.

We were welcomed by Presiding Bishop J. O. Patterson, Tenn. Governor Buford Ellington and Mayor Henry Loeb of Memphis.

The first three days were given to fasting and praying for souls everywhere, for world peace, the sick, blind, lame, dumb and the poor in spirit.

The \$100,000 per plate dinner was held at the Sheraton Peabody Hotel. Bishop McKinney attended the dinner.

"Women's Day" National Supervisor of Women's Dept., Dr. Annie L. Bailey and over 1,000 other women dressed in white marched. Invocation for the radio broadcast was given by Oregon Jurisdiction #1 State Mo. Eulah Williams, Dr. Arenia C. Mallory, pres. of Saints Industrial College, Lexington, Miss. (Church of God in Christ A.A. accredited school) accompanied by 500 of her students stated, "In order to accommodate our children, we need at least seven schools. Future plans are to construct five.

Dr. Mallory stated very humble, and grateful, "With drugs a prime concern and threat to our young people, there are no known cases of drug users or pushers in Saints Jr. College at this time.

Oregon highways traffic heavier

Traffic volume on most of Oregon's highways showed an increase in September, 1970, compared to September, 1969, according to the monthly report compiled by the Oregon State Highway Division.

A summary of the permanent traffic recorder data for rural and urban state highways showed an increase of 8.8 per cent in vehicular traffic in September, 1970, compared to September of last year.

The first nine months of 1970 showed an increase of 8.6 per cent in vehicular traffic compared to the first nine months of 1969.

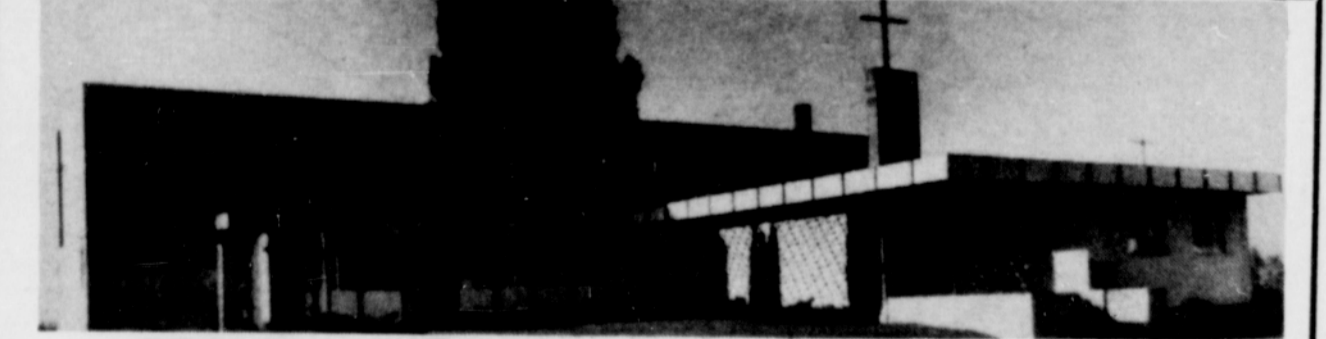
