Around 25% of her business comes from other ethnic groups who live in the "Hills" of Portland.

She has faith in the community that it will continue to make progress. Not only is she cleaning clothes but also she does her part to clean up injustice and crime in Albina.

### Black Political Power

Black political power was seen in the last Congressional elections. Black got into the state legislatures even into confederate states. Almost unbelievable victories were achieved in California and Maryland.

In congressman-elect Parren J. Mitchell, Baltimore elected the first black man below the mason-dixon line to Congress. Mitchell, who is professor of sociology at Morgan State College, said that his victory was based on new development.

In the golden state of California, the election of Wilson C. Riles to the post of Supt. of Public Instruction was an unexpected triumph against his opponent, Max Rafferty, darling of his right-wing sponsors. The perceptive voters who elected him have good reason to be proud of the results. And so can every American who believes that political campaigns should

be fought hard on issues-not race.

All these electoral victories, one encouraging factor stood out with significant prominence, the gravitation of some white voters toward black candidates. This isn't only true in Baltimore, Md., but also in California, in Ala., Georgia and a few other responsts of the Deep South

segments of the Deep South.

The hopeful sign we hope is that more and more issues and not race are becoming a dominant factor in election of candi-

dates to important public office.

When the struggle for principles can triumph over prejudice, the democratic process will attain its highest goal.
