## Kitchen Tips

### ANGEL FOOD CAKE FOR CHRISTMAS

10 egg whites  
1 1/2 Cups of sugar  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
1 Cup of flour  
1 teaspoon Cream of Tartar  
Beat the eggs until stiff but not dry. Add vanilla. Combine the flour and cream of tartar and sugar and sift six times. Fold this mixture into the eggs using a large tablespoon. Bake in a very slow oven (around 300 degrees) for about 1 hour.

### FROSTING

2 Cups of sugar  
1/2 Cup of water  
2 egg whites  
Citric Acid  
1 teaspoon Vanilla  
Boil the sugar and water until it 'ropes'. Beat the egg whites until very stiff and then pour in your syrup, beating the eggs all the while until it lumps. Then put in about as much citric acid "as you can put on a ten-cent piece," to make it white. Add vanilla, when cold, take knife and spread on cake.
