Mr. Strayhand has presented a new challenging program which promise to take the Union Fellowship to new regions of spiritual enrichment.

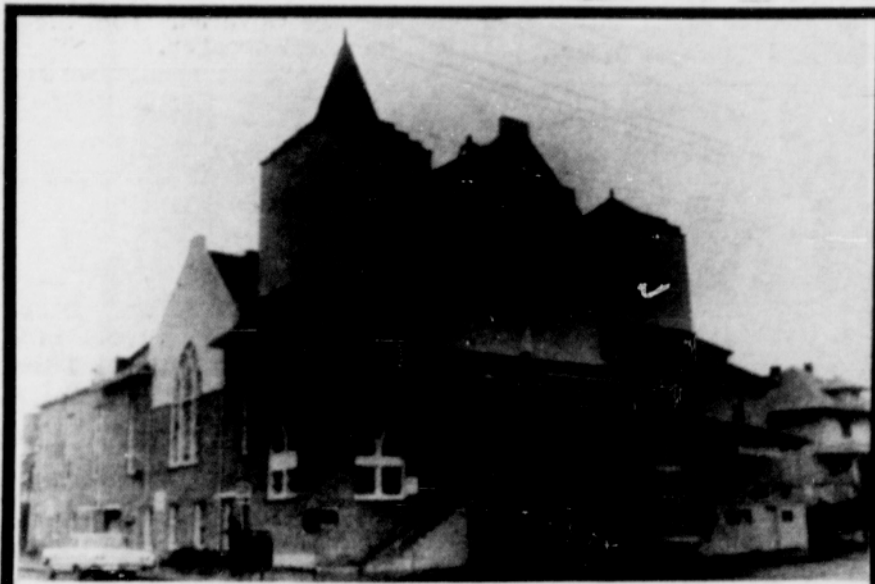
Meet Thomas L. Strayhand (Rev.), new President of the Union Fellowship elected last December during the annual election held at Highland Baptist.

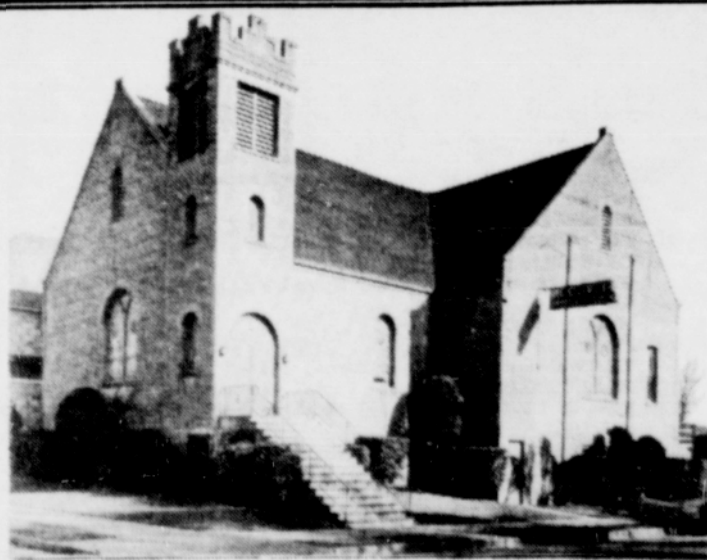
