Board Post up election

Two posts on the Board of Dir. of Portland Community College will be filled at the May 3 election. One post is from zone 4 of the Metropolitan Area Education District, including approximately the attendance areas of Washington, Benson, Monroe and Grant -High Schools.

The other post is from zone 5 including approximately the attendance areas of Cleveland and Franklin High Schools.

All attendance areas in both sones are within Portland School District 1].

Manley J. Bakkensen, an executive of wholesale grocery concern, now represents zone.4. Carl R. Neil, an attorney, is the incumbent from zone 5. Both are veterans of the College Board

having been elected when the Board was originally constituted. Both plan to seek re-election to the Board.

Petitions for candidates who wish to seek election to either post are available at the office of John Weldon, Multnomah County registrar of elections(1040 S. E. Morrison St., Portland); from the Multnomah Intermediate Education District offices (220 SE 102 Ave., Portland); or at the PCC Administration offices, 12000 SW 49th Ave., Portland.

The petitioner must be a legal resident of the zone he seeks to represent. Petitions must carry the signatures of 25 voters residing in the zone, and must be filed not later than 5 p.m., 30 day before th election date.


