

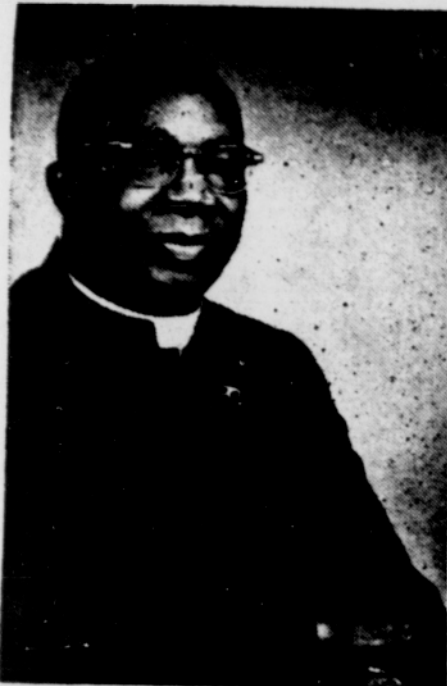

Notes from McKinney Temple

Bishop celebrates 26 successful years

Bishop W.L. McKinney, (who has a Doctor of Divinity Degree) and Mrs. M. McKinney came to Oregon from Los Angeles, California.

He was appointed State Overseer of Oregon by the Late Senior Bishop Charles Harrison Masor, on 5th day of December 1945. His main purpose in mind was to build Oregon Churches of God in Christ.

At the time of his arrival here, there was only four small missions.

He organized a small mission at 101 West Burnside and was there until 1945, when he appointed Elder B. T. Wells, who was serving as Assistant Pastor, as Pastor.

Others he inspired during those time of great difficulties were: times of great difficulties were: Elder H. D. Williams, now deceased and Elder J. F. Crear.

In 1946 he assumed the mission at 5th and Flanders with immediate thoughts to buy or build a house for God and God's people.

In 1947 with a few members he raised ten thousand dollars to make the down payment on a church.

He gave \$200.00, and Mother McKinney was the first lady to give \$100.00.

Others gave \$50.00 - \$200.00. Bishop and Mother McKinney

also mortgaged their property for three thousand dollars.

The property he purchased was the Zion Hill Church on Vancouver Ave. which was later paid in full in 1957.

A total investment of over \$25,000.00.

In 1960 he took the Pastorate in Klamath Falls, Oregon.

In 1961 a new church was built and appraised at \$40,000.00.

In 1965 the property at North Vancouver Ave., was sold and the present church (McKinney Temple) was purchased.

It was paid in full and has been appraised for over \$100,000.00.

In 1954, December 14, Bishop was consecrated to the Bishopric by the late Charles Harrison, Mason, National & International Leader & Founder of the Churches of God in Christ.

July 24, 1955, honor and double honor was bestowed upon by the Trinity Hall College & Seminary, Springfield, Illinois, and Dr. Arenia C. Mallory of All Saints Industrial Jr. College, Lexington Mississippi presented him with the Doctor of Divinity Degree.

He serves the National Church as 2nd Vice President of the Superannuation Board; Vice Chairman Judiciary Board, and the Board of Bishops.

He is active civic and social.

He has approximately thirteen churches under his jurisdiction in Oregon, ranging from Portland, Klamath Falls and La Grande.

Just in January of this year Mother McKinney loaned the church the amount needed to purchase a new furnace.

Bishop who is 78 years old, with his wife beside him is a blessing to all mankind and a firm believer in the Almighty God.

Some of the lectures will be provided by members of the Hospital medical and nursing staff.

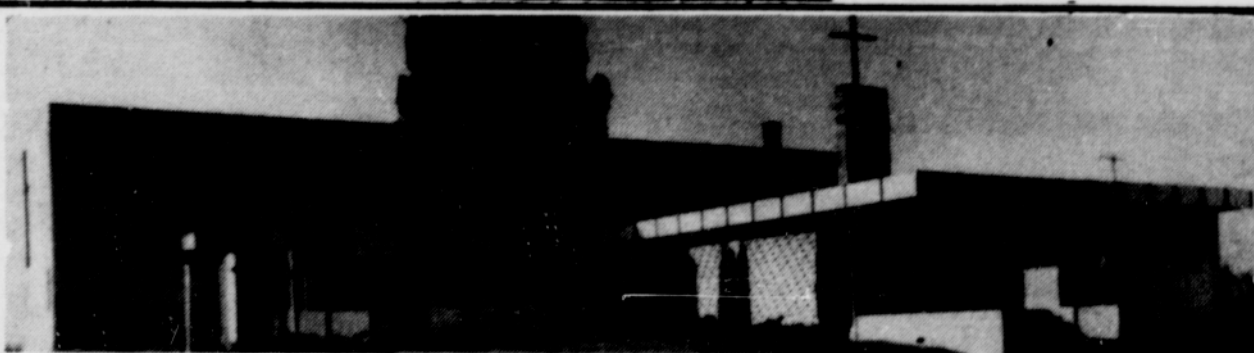
A certificate will be awarded to those who complete the program.
