Media training for minorities

This special media training program for minority groups sponsored each summer by Columbia University's Graduate School of Journalism barely survived the economic axe this year.

Elie Abel, dean of the school, announced last week, after nearly three months of negotiations, that the 11-week program country "For the first time in its four will begin June 23 for approximately 30 enrollees recruited from across the country.

"For the first time in its four year history, half the summer program will be financed by two of the major networks, CBS and NBC each contributing \$90,000," said Abel.

This will be added to a \$180,000 Ford Foundation grant, which the school has had on hand for several months.

Use of those funds hinged on

the agreement or commercial networks to bear a portion of the cost that Ford previously has paid for in full.

"The significance of this is that even in times of shrinking revenues, two of the networks have seen the need to increase the pool of trained minority talent," Abel said.

The trainees will be employed by affiliate stations in reportorial level jobs, which are guaranteed before training starts guaranteed. During the past three summer sessions, 93 minority group members have been trained and gainfully employed.

The only major drawback in this year's program is that print journalism will not be offered.

Officials of the program did not state the reasons why. They said about 150 applications have already been received.

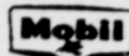
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
