I was asked to represent Hawaii - I refused. Though I would give my life for my son I do not want to completely destroy a nation in order that he be freed, nor add to more of our own men's deaths. I don't think he would want me to!

Granted we have some good men in Washington who want the U.S. to have the Godly decency and courage to get out - but apparently not enough of them. So we continue to pursue this war no matter how many hundreds of thousands of lives it costs! The truth of the matter is that all our sons in Vietnam are POWs.
