Firm Wrist Important

Your arm, your wrist and the ball should perform a unit, not a loose-hinged set of parts. Therefore, keep your wrist firm as you deliver the ball. Permitting the hand to turn to the right or left will definitely affect the path of your ball.



Keep Grip Snug

Women bowlers sometimes tend to loosen their grip on the ball in an attempt to get more action. If this is carried to an extreme, it will cause two things both bad: your hand will quickly become tired and you'll lose control. Grip so that there is no more than a pencil's width between your palm and the ball.
