McCloskey

REPRESENTATIVE PAUL N. "PETE" MCCLOSKEY

California's maverick Congressman Paul N. "Pete" McCloskey will deliver a major address at Lewis and Clark College, Saturday, May 22nd, on behalf of the Young Voters for Peace.

Representative McCloskey, now in his third term from San Mateo County's 11th Congressional District, is a vigorous opponent of the Nixon Administration's "wind down the war" policy in Vietnam. McCloskey, a highly decorated veteran of the Korean war and a Lt. Colonel in the Marine Corps reserve, has promised to run against Nixon in 1972 if no one of greater prominence presents himself.

Both a practicing attorney and a teacher of law, McCloskey first gained national attention four years ago when he defeated Shirley Temple Black in a special election. He decided to enter politics actively in 1963 after the Birmingham bombings. President John F. Kennedy called a conference of lawyers, urging them to undertake civil rights cases. Deeply committed to civil rights, McCloskey began to lay plans to enter politics. Also through the law firm where he worked, he handled many cases, without payment, on behalf of black adolescents accused of crimes but who could not afford first-line legal defense.

In his 1964 campaign for Congress, McCloskey carried the black community of East Palo Alto against all odds, being the first Republican to do so since 1936. He is outraged by Nixon's "Southern strategy" which in his words "plays politics with racism." He fought the Carswell appointment.

McCloskey arrives at Portland International Airport 11:00 a.m. Western Airlines Flight 408. At 11:30 a.m. there will be a press conference in the Airport Quiet Room. At 1:00 p.m. a reception at Congress Hotel Pomelan Room will give an opportunity for a vigorous exchange between guests and McCloskey. At 5:00 p.m. the public is invited to the Public Address at Lewis and Clark College, Stamm Dining Room, followed by question and answer sessions.

McCloskey will be greeted at the airport by Robert Parsons, National Chairman of the Young Voters for Peace, host group for McCloskey's appearance. Last week, in a Portland press conference, Parsons explained the YVP's pledge to vote only for Congressional candidates who insist on a specific withdrawal date from Indo China. The group seeks such pledges from students across the nation, in the belief that it is easier to change Congressional policy than it is to change Administration policy.
