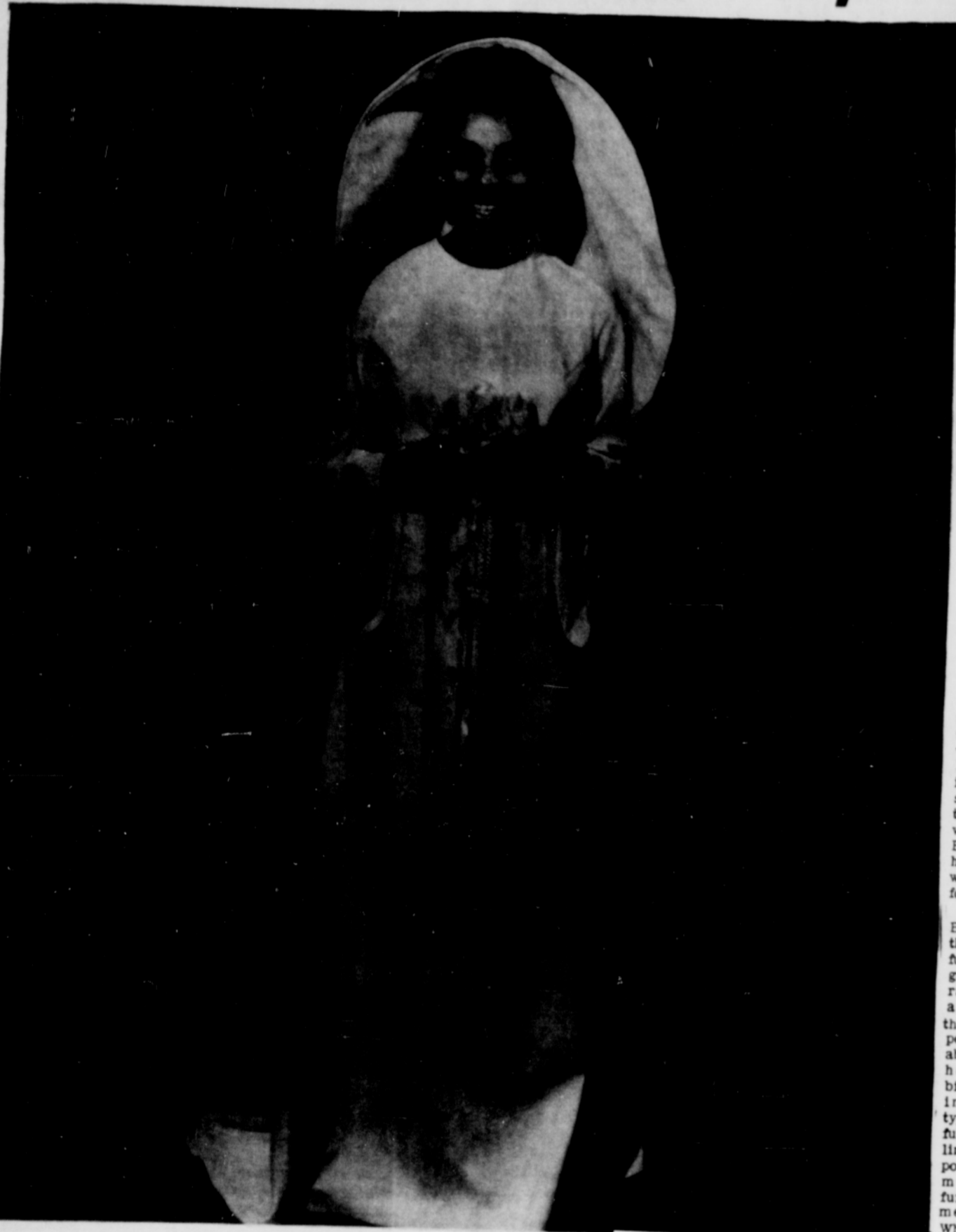


Married in Church Ceremony

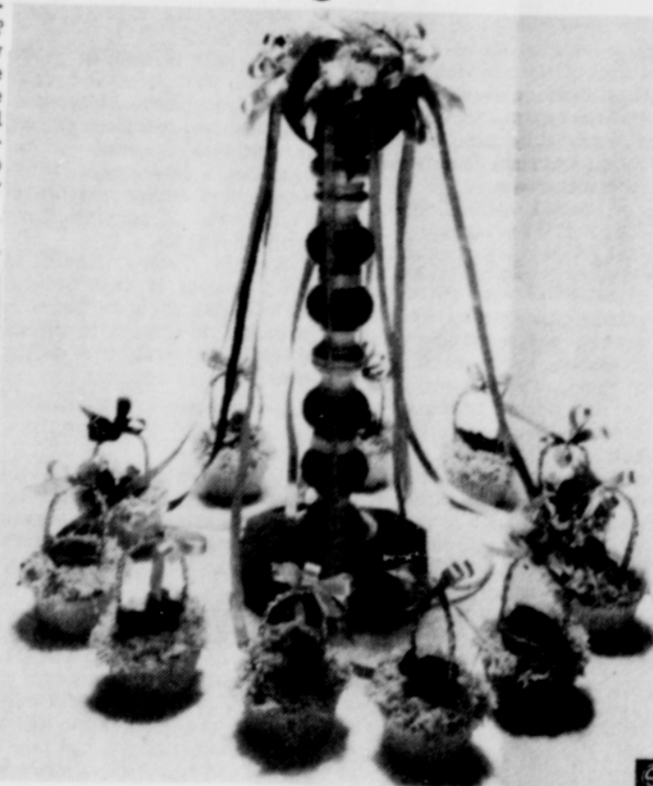

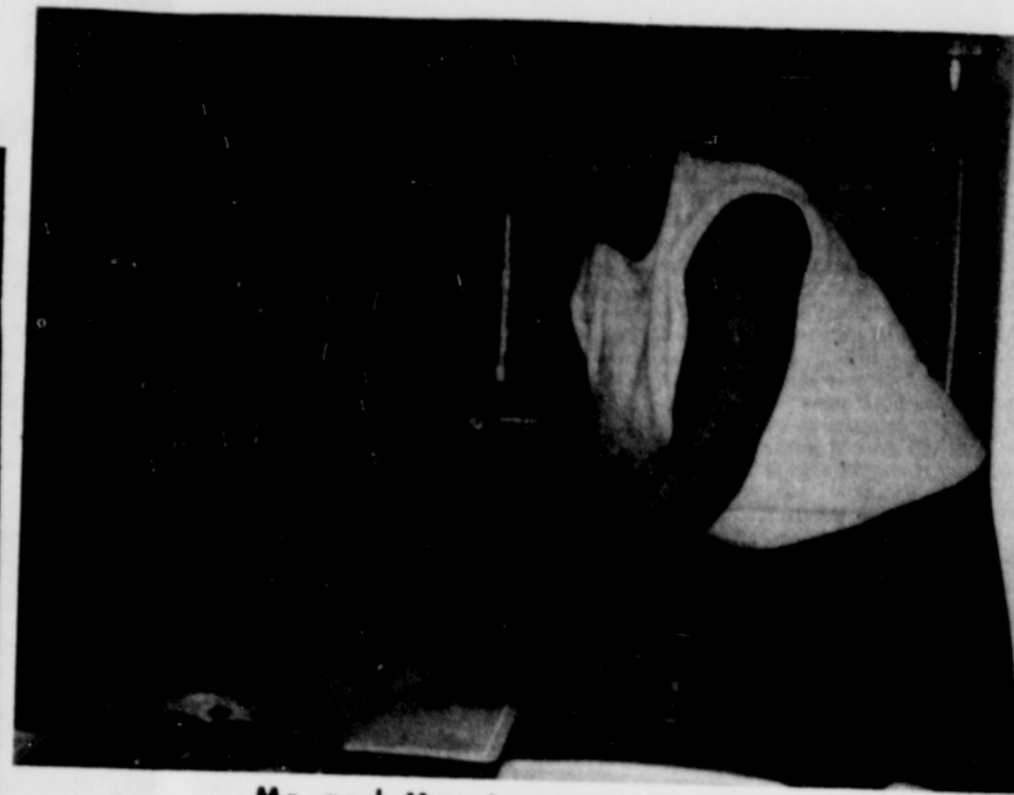

Prepare yellow cake mix according to package directions, adding orange peel to mix. Place paper cupcake liners in cupcake pans, then spoon batter into papers filling them about 2/3 full. Bake as directed on package. Cool. With a sharp knife, cut a cone from the center of the top of each cupcake. Fill hole with some of the cranberry sauce. Replace top of cupcake. Prepare frosting mix as directed on package, but blending in peanut butter and enough milk to make it the proper spreading consistency. Spread frosting on cupcakes. Tint coconut with green food coloring by sprinkling coconut with a few drops of coloring and rubbing coloring into coconut with the back of a spoon. Sprinkle coconut around the outer edge of each cupcake. Fill center with candied flowers, small gumdrops, colored mints, crumbled peppermint candy, etc. Shape pipe cleaners into handles, covering pipe cleaners with small strips of aluminum foil if desired. Push ends of handle into top of each cupcake.

Visiting from Baltimore

Mr. and Mrs. James E. Flossie Boddie arrived Wednesday from their home in Baltimore, Md., to visit with daughter, Brenda, who is Citizens Participation Coordinator at Model Cities.

The Boddies, who live where the weather is extremely hot in the summer and cold in the winter, were unaware that Portland weather was as warm as it was when they arrived. It seems Brenda has been saying that we had a cool spring so; they were thinking it felt like Baltimore. Since they will be here until August 1, hopefully the weather will not be uncomfortable.

Boddie, who has been with Bethlehem Steel for 27 years, is the operator of an open hearth furnace. A quiet man, Boddie gave the feeling that he would rather operate the huge furnace, and manage his subordinates, than he would tell what his position was. Further questions about the equipment proved that he has a position of responsibility, that is an important step in the manufacture of many types of steel. The particular furnace Boddie operates has a limestone lining placed in the pot first, then iron ore and scrap metal are added. A blast furnace then sends over hot metal; so hot it runs like water. When the pot attains a tempera-

ture of 2500 degrees testing is started. He explained that the testing is done with a spoon that goes in the side of the furnace with a 8 ft. handle. Tests are made for carbon content. When the carbon rate is reached, at 2900 degrees of heat, the metal goes into the ladle.

Boddie said his favorite food was beefsteak and he appears not to have an extra ounce of weight. His position at Bethlehem must use up every bit of protein.

Mrs. Boddie is a sparkling, outgoing, friendly lady. One immediately associates her working with people, and she does. Employed by John Hopkins Hospital in the Surgical Dept. for 23 years, she works with doctors, nurses, patients, and the hospital staff. She manages a unit where she checks the requisitions for X-rays, supervises the temperature charts, and perhaps most important is responsible for patients going for physical therapy. She started as a nurse's aid and has made a career for herself.

The Boddies enjoy traveling. On holidays and over weekends they motor up and down the eastern coastline enjoying the scenery and visiting relatives.

Hobbies? They are busy people. He enjoys his garden, fixes cars, fishes, and most of

all the Orioles and baseball. Brooks Robinson is his favorite player at the minute, but he is loyal to the Orioles.
