QUESTION: How much did Nixon's inauguration cost? I have heard estimates up to several million dollars.

ANSWER: The total bill for the inauguration probably will be about \$4 million, but about 65 per cent of this amount is paid for by private funds. Congress appropriated \$1.5 million for construction, and police and fire protection for the thousands of visitors who came to Washington for the event. But all the pageantry and regalia of the balls, concerts and receptions is paid for by persons who attend. You might be interested to know that a person who attended five of the major events offered would end up spending \$795 in tickets for a first class weekend. There were even tickets for the parade ranging from \$5 to \$50. Tickets for one concert ranged from \$30 to \$5,000. Another source

of revenue comes from sale of souvenirs, generally ranging from \$5 to \$150. The advance cost of staging the elaborate unofficial events is provided by interest free loans given by local businesses. If the inaugural committee has any money left after expenses, a portion of it will be given to charity.

QUESTION: I have been deeply disturbed by periodic bombing renewals in Vietnam and am considering not paying the Federal excise tax on my telephone calls. I understand this tax is directly allocated for weapons of war. Is this true?


ANSWER: No, however, this seems to be a fairly common misconception. This tax goes into a "general" fund in the Treasury Department, and I would strongly urge you not to stop paying the tax. You could be subjected to criminal prosecution for tax evasion, or the Internal Revenue Service could garnish your salary to cover the amount due plus interest and penalties. There also is a proposed regulation to cut off all service to persons who refuse to pay the tax. IRS tells me that the excise tax on telephones adds about \$1 billion a year to the general fund of the Treasury, and it is, of course, conceivable a portion of it could go toward the war.
