

Hines enters Portland meet

The year was 1968 and Jim Hines was on top of the track world.

He was the new "World's Fastest Human", and nobody questioned it. Well, maybe Charlie Greene going into the Olympic Games in Mexico City, but certainly not afterward.

The Oakland, California, sprinter had set the world 100 meter record at 9.9, joining Green and Ronnie Ray Smith in the first-ever sub-10.0 clocking at Sacramento.

Three times he ran 10.0 in the Olympic Trials. No one beat him.

The pattern was to continue as Hines ran back-to-back 10.0s to gain the finals in the high altitude of Mexico City. There was little doubt who would win.

Hines did not disappoint, running another 9.9, the only man in history to crack the impregnable 10.0 barrier twice. He was the Olympic champion. Several days later he came from behind to anchor the U.S. 400-meter relay team to victory.

But the youngster faced the dilemma every track and field performer prior to this year has faced. Where to turn? Bob Hayes made it in pro football, so Hines tried. He made the Miami Dolphin roster, but that's all.

Since then he's bounded around, unable to play regularly.

But the still-youthful 26-year-old speedster may be able to regain that "World's Fastest Human" title after all. The International Track

Association, the first-ever pro track tour, could solve a lot of problems for the soft-spoken Hines.

In a football uniform, Hines was an outsider. In a track uniform, he still is one of the most feared names in the sport. All this may explain why Jim Hines is wearing a permanent smile these days. Hines will be running in

the new professional Inter-national Track Association (ITA) track meet scheduled for Friday, March 30, at 8 p.m. at the Memorial Coliseum. Tickets are \$6, \$5 and \$4, and are on sale at the Coliseum box office, Stevens and Sons in the Lloyd Center, Meier and Frank downtown and Lincoln Savings in Beaverton.
