If you owned or were buying the home where you lived on December 31st, 1972, make less than \$13,000 and have not filed for property tax relief—you probably should. The HOMEOWNER'S PROPERTY TAX RELIEF LAW is in its second year. Last year less than half the people due tax relief did not receive their rightful refund. Why? They did not ask, they did not file their yellow HOMEOWNER'S PROPERTY TAX RELIEF APPLICATION.

If the form confuses you, at least fill in four boxes on the yellow form. On the yellow form, fill in the boxes shaded and circled in the mini-sample printed at the right. Sign your name at the bottom of the yellow form and return in the enclosed envelope. You could receive up to \$400 for your efforts!

Put in your name.
Put in your address on December 31st, 1972.

Fill in your household income last year (1972). If you are not sure of the amount, fill in your very best guess. BOX 15.

Put big X in the-NO-boxes at the end of lines F, G, and H.

Your property taxes for 1972. Call your lender who you pay monthly if you don't get the tax bill. They will know the amount of taxes. If you can't find out what the property tax was, your tax probably was 3% of what you paid for your home. (Divide the price you paid for your home by 100, multiply by 3 and you are close. Put the amount in Box 16).

Sign your name or put your mark at the bottom of the yellow form.
