## COMMUNITY CALENDAR

Film and television star George Takei will be in Portland Saturday, June 2, to address the Japanese American Citizens League families and friends at Portland Community. Takei is well known for his part as Su Lu in television's "Star Trek" series. Mr. Takei will discuss "Racism in the Media", tracing the influence of newspapers and radio to the early 1900's when Americans were made aware of the "yellow peril" threat. Later, after the bombing of Pearl Harbor, newsreels and papers significantly influenced the government in its decision to forcefully evacuate 110,000 Nikkei (Japanese-Americans) to wartime relocation camps. Racial tensions relaxed after World War II; however, with the increase in competitive trade between Japan and the United States in recent years, racism is reoccurring. "Media's influence in shaping racial images is felt by many groups in our society," asserts Takei. The public is invited to attend the free presentation in room A7 ST at PCC's Sylvania center, 12000 S.W. 49th Avenue, at 8 p.m. The program is being presented by the Japanese American Citizens League in cooperation with Portland Community College.
