Congressman Wendell Wyatt will speak on "Progress in Perspective" at Portland Community College graduation ceremonies June 10, at 2 p.m. in the college gymnasium, 12000 SW 49th Avenue.

President Amo De Bernardis will present associate degrees, certificates, or high school diplomas to approximately 1200 students who have completed requirements. Father James Manning, St. Phillip's Episcopal Church, will give the invocation and benediction. James Welty, Portland, will present organ selections prior to and following the exercises.

Graduates, their families and friends are invited to join President and Mrs. De Bernardis at a reception in the commons following the ceremony.

City Commissioner Mildred A. Schwab will speak at commencement exercises for the graduates of Oregon Episcopal Schools (St. Helen's Hall, Bishop Dagwell Hall) on June 8th. Graduation ceremonies for the 27 seniors will be held at Trinity Episcopal Church at 8 p.m.

Following the ceremonies, a reception will be held in Kempton Hall at the church.

Announcement was made by Dr. Katie E. Whickam, president of the National Beauty Culturists' League, Inc., that their 54th annual convention will be held in Denver, Colorado in the Denver-Hilton Hotel July 29 through August 9, 1973. This is the largest all-Black women's organization in the U.S.A., consisting of over 40,000 women located in 42 states of the union, in the Bahamas and in South America.

A public hearing on proposed amendments to State Health Division rules pertaining to methods of determining alcoholic content of blood will be held in Room 12 of the State Office Building, Salem. The proposals include the approval of two additional types of breath testing devices for use by Oregon state and local police. Both new devices are electronic methods which perform the entire blood alcohol analysis automatically and will print out the breath test results.

One of Salem's most popular tourist attractions, the guided trip to the tower of the State Capitol, was started for the current season on Memorial Day. It was announced by Victor Fryer, travel information director for the Highway Division.

Trips to the tower are scheduled every half hour from 9:00 to 11:30 a.m. and from 1:00 to 3:30 p.m. seven days a week. Mrs. Fances Bell, chief of the Capitol Guide Service, said. Regulations require that those 18 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult. Mrs. Bell pointed out that there are 121 steps in the spiral staircase leading to the top of the tower. There is no elevator.

When one reaches the top of the tower, he has an unsurpassed view of Salem and the surrounding countryside. This is particularly true on a clear day when the mountains can be seen in all their splendor. These include Mt. Hood, Mt. Jefferson, Mt. St. Helens, Mt. Adams, and the Three Sisters. It also provides one a closeup view of the Pioneer standing atop the tower.
