## Portland schedules German Arts Festival

The second German Arts Festival on the Pacific, a week of German cultural events co-sponsored by Portland State University, the City of Portland, the German

Aid Society, and the Goethe Institute, Munich, Germany, will be held in Portland June 23-30.

The first German Arts Festival, two years ago, was launched with a grant from the Goethe Institute to honor Dr. H. Frederick Peters, PSU professor of German and comparative literature. Dr. Peters also heads the Central European Studies Center and founded the Deutsche Sommerschule am Pazifik, a summer program now in its 16th year.

Puppets, films, vocal and instrumental music, drama, mime, special art and documentary exhibits highlight this year's festival. It will open at 8 p.m. Saturday, June 23, with a performance by Albrecht Roser, a puppeteer from Stuttgart, in the Caroline Berg Swann Auditorium at the Portland Art Museum, 1219 SW Park. Roser's "Clown Gustaf and Ensemble" will present a random series of comedy and other scenes intended for an audience over 15 years of age. The puppeteer, who performed in Portland's first German Arts Festival, draws heavily on theater, dance,

cabaret and pantomime to provide entertainment which he describes as "not language bound".

## College honors Parks

Director Gordon Parks, currently filming Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer's "The Super Cops", was awarded a Doctorate of Humane Letters by St. Olaf's College in Northfield, Minnesota.

Parks, who also directed MGM's highly successful "Shaft" and "Shaft's Big

Score", already holds honorary degrees from the Maryland Institute of Fine Arts, Boston University and Connecticut University.

## Brown signs "Slams"

Jim Brown, the former Cleveland football star, has been signed to star in Penelope Production's "Slams", an action drama which follows the exploits of a prisoner and his fight against the penal system.

Brown's film credits include "The Dirty Dozen", "Rio Conchos", "The Mercenaries", "Ice Station Ze-

bra", "Riot", "Dark of the Sun", "The Split", "tick... tick... tick...", "100 Rifles", "El Condor", "The Grasshopper", "I Escaped From Devil Island", "Slaughter", "Slaughter 2", and "Black Gun".

"Slams", produced by Gene Corman, marks the directorial debut of Jonathan Kaplan. The screenplay was written by Richard L. Adams.

## Intruders recording reflects philosophy

This passage from Kenny Gamble best reflects the philosophy of the Intruders, and their current Gamble album, fittingly titled, "Save the Children". But still another album, a brand new release, also maps out the thoughts of this talented quartet.

"Intruders' Super Hits", also on the Gamble label, is a

repackage of the group's previous hits. Included in the LP is a brief recorded history of the group, from its first single, "A Love That's Real" to such smashes as "Together", "Love is Like a Baseball Game", "(We'll Be United)" and "Cowboys to Girls".

And, like "Save the Children", "Intruders' Super Hits" features the artistry of vocalists Phil Terry, Robert "Big Sonny" Edwards, Eugene "Bird" Daughtry and Sam "Little Sonny" Brown. The repackaging, now available in stores across the country, was produced by Kenny Gamble and Leon Huff.

## PSU begins registration

Registration in Portland State University's regular eight-week summer session will be held Monday, June 18 from 7:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. and from 5 to 7 p.m. in the Health and Physical Education Building, 950 SW Hall.

There are no age or admission requirements to attend PSU's summer session. Students simply obtain a packet release ticket from the Registrar's Office, located in the lobby of Neuberger Hall, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Thursday, Friday or Monday, June 14, 15 or 18 and exchange the ticket for registration materials June 18.

Students may register in full-year courses in 11 academic fields ranging from accounting to foreign languages in PSU's three concentrated short terms: June 18-July 13, July 16-Aug. 8 and Aug. 9-31. Concentrated term classes allow students to pick up a deficiency in a sequence or complete a full-year's work during the summer. Registration in each concentrated term is open up to the first day of the term. After June 18 all registration will be held in the summer session office, 614 SW Montgomery.

Registration in special programs, beginning each week throughout the summer, is open now in the summer session office.

## Sabin teacher best

Portland teacher Margaret Doud has been selected as an outstanding elementary teacher of America for 1973 by a national publication.

The awards volume "Outstanding Elementary Teachers of America" will feature Miss Doud in its 1973 edition.

Miss Doud was selected by a national board of educators, industrialists and service organization presidents for her talents in the classroom, contributions to research, administrative abilities, civic service and professional recognition.

A veteran teacher, Miss Doud has taught youngsters in grades 1-5 in schools in Michigan and Oregon for 13 years. Currently she teaches reading to students in grades 1-4 at Sabin Elementary School.

Miss Doud is now eligible to receive one of five Outstanding Elementary Teacher of the Year Award trophies. If she wins, Sabin School will receive an unrestricted grant of \$500.
