Ten other girls are attending Westwind from the Northeast YWCA. Westwind is the YWCA youth camp, located at the mouth of the Salmon River on the edge of the Pacific Ocean. The girls will participate in activities including drama, crafts, art, sports and cook-outs. Canoeing and hiking will acquaint the campers with the 700 acres of beach, meadow, hidden lake, woods and mountain trails. Girls age 8 to 17 attend Westwind. Other camp programs include a pioneer ranch camp at the same time as regular camp, and adult workshops on yoga, the environment and pottery, offered later in the summer.

## Portland Deltas attend national

Delta Sigma Theta, a national public service sorority made up mostly of Black women, is preparing for the biggest national convention in Atlanta on August 12-17, in its 60-year history. Considered by many as one of the most civically active and effectively organized and operated national women's organizations in the country, Delta has a long history of involvement in national and local public service programs. Its membership now stands at 65,000, with 460 chapters.

Four members of the Portland sorority will attend the national conference: President Marion Simms, Treasurer Lillian Cunningham, Ellen Law and Yvonne Williams. The Portland chapter has a current membership of approximately 35. Their officers are: Vice-President, Jewel Bowman; Corresponding Secretary, Valystine Bell; Recording Secretary, Jean Hartzog; and Parliamentarian, Pat Dickerson.

The Deltas are a service sorority. Local projects include a Black Heritage Branch, scholarships, a workshop on drugs and a sickle cell anemia project. Emphasis this year for the national and the local will be on social action - child care, federal cutbacks, and other action of community concern.

Mrs. Benbow said the Deltas, in their convention theme of "Delta Women - Breaking New Ground", will give special attention to national program priorities and a blueprint for action. A series of convention symposiums will be devoted to revenue sharing, educational and job opportunities for Black women, community involvement and career development, human and social imperatives for the world of telecommunication, and women's rights in the 70s.

A Career Development Institute will be operated for Delta members, including interviews and recruitment by major corporations and federal government agencies. Other convention highlights include seminars on counseling and guidance for higher education, with personnel from College Entrance Board and other organizations participating. Mass media and communications technology will be featured in exhibits of hard and soft computer ware, television and radio equipment and examples of printed materials. Mrs. Benbow said: "This will be a working, active, skill-building convention. For the first two and a half days we will be concerned with internal Delta development, taking a long, hard look at who we are, as an organization of predominantly Black women, what we are doing, and if not, why not. "We will deal forthrightly with the social issues of the day, especially those around which governmental actions influence the lives of minority citizens. 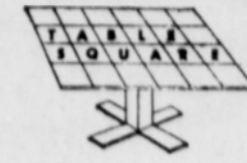
