



The Federal Trade Commission set June 1st as the effective date for regulating door-to-door sales by giving consumers a three-day cooling off period in which to cancel purchases or sales contracts without penalty or fee. This cooling off period applies to consumer goods or services costing \$25 or more. Oregon already has a cooling off period if the purchase is \$50 or more, but after June 1st this amount also will be \$25 in Oregon.

So remember your right to a three-day period in which you can change your mind about a purchase from a door-to-door salesman.
