

# German theologian speaks

Dr. Helmut Thielicke, world renowned German theologian, will be on Concordia's campus Thursday, October 9th to address a convocation. The topic of his presentation is "Ethics and Freedom." The convocation will be held at St. Michael's Lutheran Church on the corner of Northeast Dekum and 29th Avenue, starting at 10:00 a.m.

From 1936-1940, Dr. Thielicke was a professor at Heidelberg University until he was dismissed from his duties for his bold criticism of Nazi policies. Though he was forbidden, like Dietrich Bonhoeffer and other pastors, to travel or speak publicly, he taught courses in theology and lectured to thousands during the height of the Allied bombing. In 1960, Thielicke became the first Protestant theologian to hold the post of

Rector at the University of Hamburg. Dr. Thielicke has visited the United States on two previous occasions. During 1956, he was a guest professor at Drew University, and lectured at Union, Princeton, University of Chicago, and Washington D.C. In 1963 most of his time was spent traveling across the country, preaching and conducting sessions with pastors, teachers, students and newsmen.

Many of his works are published, with over seventeen in English alone. Presently his theological works are receiving wide attention, especially his four volumes, **Theological Ethics**. Among his other works are: **How The World Began**, **Nihilism**, **Between God and Satan**, and **Life Can Begin Again**.

The convocation is open to the public without charge.

Generally speaking, what veterans are eligible for VA benefits?

A. All veterans  
B. Only veterans with an honorable or a general discharge  
C. Veterans with honorable or general discharge are eligible (which includes 97 percent of Vietnam Era veterans); those with dishonorable discharges are not those with undesirable or bad conduct discharges may or may not be eligible, depending upon an individual determination by the VA
