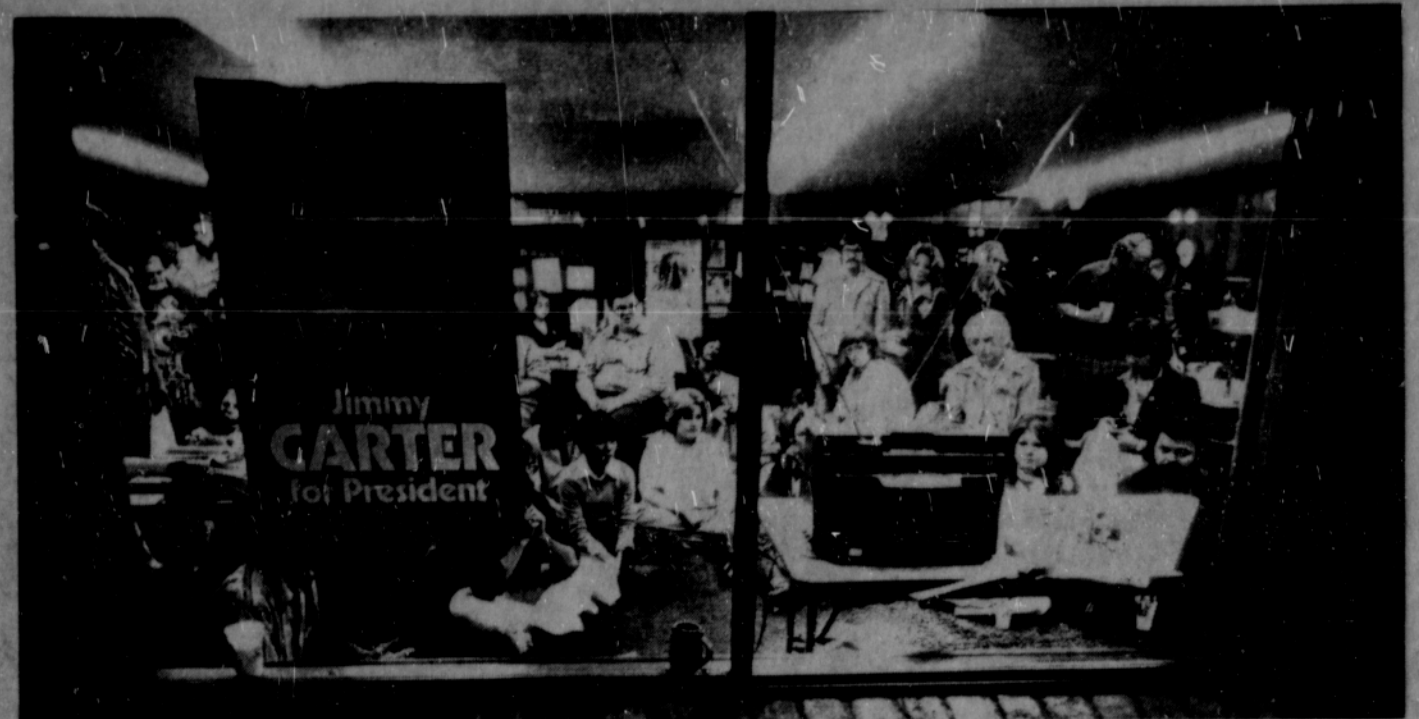

State Police seek applicants

The Department of Oregon State Police is interested in persons with a good moral background, a strong desire to succeed, strong motivation and a belief in public service.

Special efforts are being made to attract qualified minority and female applicants.

All applications for employment will be given consideration without regard to race, color, national origin, religion, sex, political affiliation or marital status.

Applicants must be 21 years of age for regular membership and 18 years of age for employment as a Cadet during the summer months. Applicants must be high school graduates or have passed a GED equivalency test. Height and weight must be in proportion and vision in each eye may not exceed 20/40 uncorrected. Applicants must be willing to be stationed anywhere in the state.

Applications for the Cadet Program will be accepted September 1st through November 30th of each year. Regular Membership applications accepted beginning January 1st, 1977 and applications for Speciality fields are accepted continuously.

Pay is determined by length of service,

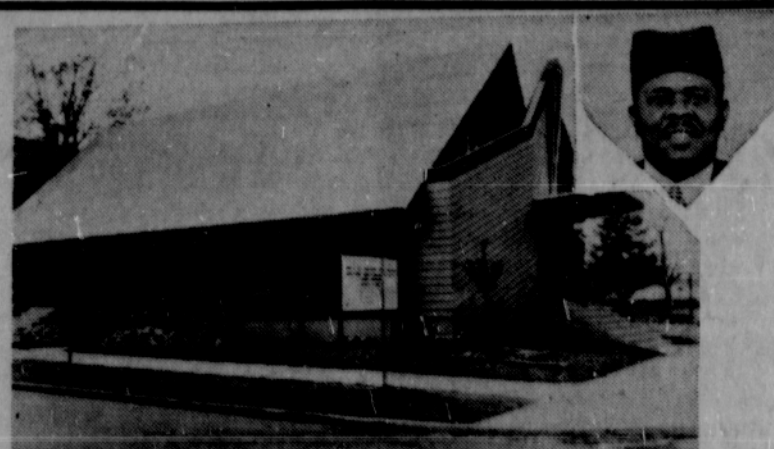

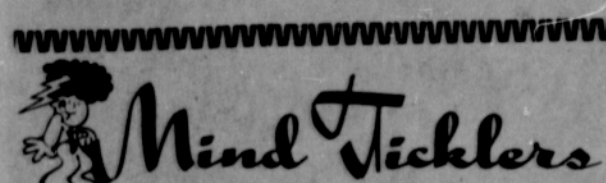
