NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS SANITARY SEWERAGE PROJECT CITY OF REDMOND, OREGON

Sealed proposals for furnishing of all materials, equipment, labor and services of all kinds for the construction of the Sewerage Collection Facilities for the City of Redmond, Oregon will be received at the office of the City Administrator until 8:30 p.m., P.S.T., on Tuesday the 22nd of February, 1977, and thereafter will be publicly opened and read aloud at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Redmond in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Redmond, Oregon. The Contract will be awarded or proposals rejected within forty-five (45) days after opening.

The work contemplated is divided into five schedules as follows:

Schedule 1:

Construction of the lateral sewage collection system and interceptor sewage collection system including approximately 60,000 linear feet of 8-inch to 15-inch gravity sewer pipe, 10,000 linear feet of 4-inch and 6-inch service connection pipe, manholes, surface restoration, seven highway undercrossings, five railroad undercrossings, two private railroad undercrossings, five major canal crossings, one dry pit type pump station and other appurtenances.

Schedule 2:

Construction of the lateral sewage collection system and interceptor sewage collection system including approximately 45,000 linear feet of 8-inch to 12-inch gravity sewer line, 9,000 linear feet of 4-inch and 6-inch service connection pipe, manholes, surface restoration, eleven highway undercrossings, one major canal crossing and other appurtenances.

Schedule 3:

Construction of the lateral sewage collection system and interceptor sewage collection system including approximately 49,500 linear feet of 8-inch to 24-inch gravity sewer pipe, 8,600 linear feet of 4-inch and 6-inch service connection pipe, manholes, surface restoration, four major canyon rim excavations, and other appurtenances.

Schedule 4:

Construction of the lateral sewage collection system and interceptor sewage collection system including approximately 64,500 linear feet of 8-inch to 18-inch gravity sewer pipe, 400 linear feet of 4-inch pressure sewer pipe, 11,500 linear feet of 4-inch to 6-inch service connection pipe, manholes, surface restoration, nine highway undercrossings, one railroad undercrossing, six major canal crossings, one canyon rim crossing, one wet well mounted type pump station and other appurtenances.

Schedule 5:

Construction of the lateral sewage collection system and interceptor sewage collection system including approximately 27,900 linear feet of 8-inch to 12-inch gravity sewer pipe, 5,600 linear feet of 4-inch to 6-inch service connection pipe, manholes, surface restoration, two major canal crossings and other appurtenances.

This fee shall be non-refundable.

Bidders must submit prequalification statements in compliance with applicable parts of Chapter 279 of Oregon Revised Statutes. Oregon State Standard Prequalification forms, if needed, may be obtained from the Engineer. These forms must be submitted to the City Administrator, City of Redmond, 455 South Seventh, Redmond, Oregon 97756, at least ten (10) days prior to the bidding date.

Each bidder shall include with the preprinted prequalification statement a written statement on the extent of his experience with rock excavation. The Contractor shall also submit the names of past clients where rock excavation has been performed and, in particular, shall refer to past experience in projects involving excavations in vesicular basalts.

All proposals must be submitted on the forms furnished with the documents, and each must be accompanied by a surety bond, cashier's check or certified check in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the aggregate amount of the proposal. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a bond equal to the amount of the proposal for the faithful performance of the contract.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the provisions of the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and requirements issued thereunder. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the Contract Documents.

The attention of bidders is directed to the requirements and conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract.

The bidder must submit with his proposal properly executed forms of "Compliance Statement" and "Certification of Non-Segregated Facilities" in compliance with the Environmental Protection Agency special requirements. Bids received without these completed forms will be considered nonresponsive. Before a contract will be awarded, the above will be subject to EPA approval.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals, to postpone the award of the Contract for a period of not to exceed 45 days, and to accept that proposal which is to the best interests of the City of Redmond.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS IRRIGATION SYSTEM CITY OF REDMOND, OREGON

Sealed proposals for furnishing of all materials, equipment, labor and services of all kinds for the construction of the Irrigation System for the City of Redmond, Oregon, will be received at City Hall, 455 South Seventh, Redmond, Oregon 97756 until February 22, 1977 and will be publicly opened and read at that time. The Contract will be awarded or proposals rejected within forty-five (45) days after the opening.

The work to be performed includes, but is not limited to, construction of 19,190 feet of 24-inch concrete sewer pipe interceptor, a 32 acre soil-cement lined holding pond, a 22 foot by 28 foot irrigation pump station, 5400 feet of eight inch and 750 feet of six inch PVC irrigation pressure main, four center pivot spray irrigation units covering 143 acres, and other site improvements.

These forms, completely filled out, should be submitted to the Engineer at least 10 (10) days prior to the bidding date. The Engineer will issue proposal forms to qualified bidders.

All proposals must be submitted on the regular forms furnished by the Engineer. No proposal will be considered unless accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond payable to the City of Redmond, for the amount equal to ten (10) percent of the total bid. The successful bidder shall furnish a performance bond satisfactory to the City in the full amount of the contract. The successful bidder, upon his failure or refusal to execute and deliver the contract and bonds within ten days after he has received notice of acceptance of his bid, shall forfeit to the City, for such failure or refusal, the security deposited with his bid.

No proposal will be received or considered by the City of Redmond or any officer of the City unless the proposal contains a statement by the bidder as a part of his proposal that the provisions required by ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the provisions of the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and requirements issued thereunder. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this Order are explained in the Contract Documents.

The attention of bidders is directed to the requirements and conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract. The project is being partially funded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The bidder must submit with his Proposal the following properly executed documents in accordance with EPA requirements:

A. Contractor's Compliance Statement (Executive Order No. 11246).
B. Non-Segregated Facilities Certification.

Bids received without these completed forms will be considered nonresponsive. Before a contract will be awarded, the above will be subject to EPA approval.

Minority Business Enterprise Program

The Oregon Department of Transportation, Highway Division, is updating its list of Minority Enterprises that are interested in performing work as contractors or subcontractors on federal-aid highway construction projects.

A minority business enterprise is defined as a business at least 50 per cent of which is owned by minority group members or, in the case of publicly owned businesses, at least 51 per cent of the stock of which is owned by minority group members. For the purpose of this definition "minority group members" are Blacks (not of Hispanic origin), Hispanics, Asian or Pacific Islanders, and American Indian or Alaska natives.

A list of interested minority business firms will be provided contractors requesting proposals to bid on federal-aid highway projects.

Minority business firms interested in performing work on federal-aid highway construction projects are invited to complete a questionnaire listing the specific type of work they are capable of performing. This questionnaire has recently been sent to those minority firms which we have already identified.
