The work consists of two 4-classroom buildings and one restroom wing for North Keene Way Elementary School, Medford, Oregon. The work shall include all site development and building construction. Buildings are to be of modular type capable of being relocated within the modular limits. Contractor to furnish design calculations for any structural spans and frame that are critical to the building's stability for approval by the Architect.

Bidders may obtain copies of Contract Documents at the office of Hunter & Shute, Architects, A.I.A., 839 East Main Street, Medford, Oregon, upon payment of \$50.00 for each set. Unsuccessful bidders and non-bidders will be refunded the full deposit upon return of complete sets of useable condition. Incomplete or damaged sets are not eligible for refund. Copies of individual sheets or sections are available to bidders from the Architect at cost, non-refundable.

Bids shall be delivered in a sealed envelope addressed to the "School District 549C, Medford, Oregon," and marked "North Keene Way Elementary School."

Attention of bidders is called to the requirements of Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 279, relating to prequalification of bidders on public contracts. Bidders are to file prequalification statements required with Hunter & Shute, Architects, 839 East Main Street, Medford, Oregon, no later than November 6, 1977. In the event that a prequalification statement has been filed with School District 549C within the current calendar year and a bidder has been accepted as a qualified bidder upon County projects, a review of the previous statement may be made to determine whether a prospective bidder is qualified to bid upon the work under consideration and additional statements may be required. School District 549C reserves the right to reject the proposal of any bidder who has not been prequalified for the class of work involved in the project.

No bid will be received or considered unless it contains a statement by the bidder as part of his bid that the provisions of ORS 279.350 relating to prevailing wage rates is complied with.

Conditions of the Contract are subject to the following:

1. Payment of prevailing wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor, or the Department of Labor, State of Oregon, whichever is higher;
2. Equal Employment Opportunity requirements (Executive Order 11246, 30 Fed. Reg. 12319 (1965);
3. Ten Percent minority enterprise requirements;
4. Copeland "Anti-Kickback" provisions; which are described in "General Conditions."

The successful bidder shall, within ten working days after written notice of award of the contract, execute the Agreement and furnish to the Owner Performance and Labor and Materials bonds in the form provided by the Architect, in favor of School District 549C of Jackson County, Oregon, of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount covering performance, material and labor payment.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders," upon the proposal form provided by the Architect, and accompanied by a cashier's check, a certified check, or a bid bond executed in favor of School District 549C of Jackson County, Medford, Oregon, in an amount of 5 percent of the base bid to be forfeited as fixed and liquidated damages should the bidder neglect or refuse to enter into a contract and provide suitable bond for the faithful performance of the work in the event a contract is awarded to him. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive all informalities. No bid will be received or considered unless the bid is accompanied by a statement by the contractor that the provisions of ORS 279.350 will be complied with in performance of the contract.

No bidder may withdraw his bid prior to bid opening unless done so in writing, signed and delivered to School District 549C prior to the opening of bids.

No bidder may withdraw his bid after the hour set for opening thereof for a period of thirty days from said bid opening.

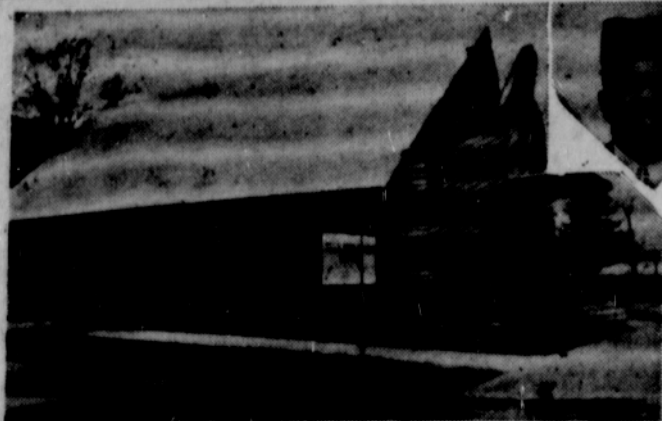
